President Jim Martin called the meeting to order at 11:00 A.M. Ann Ardoin gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance by Gary Loftin.

Members Present: President Jim Martin, Michael Thibodeaux, Robby Barousse, Mark Graffeo, Felicia Ann Hendl, Hart Bourque, Gary Loftin, Cliff Dressel and Ann Ardoin were all present. Also in attendance: Executive Secretary, Debbie Hudnall; Actuary Gary Curran; and Consultant Kari Creighton. Members absent: Rep. Pete Schneider and Sen. Butch Gautreaux. Visitor present: Lynn Jones

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Hart Bourque moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written, motion seconded by Felicia Ann Hendl. **Motion carried.**

FINANCIAL REPORTS: (Attachment 1) Treasurer Mark Graffeo presented the financial reports as of June 30, 2007, reporting total assets of \$334,985,576 and a total fund balance of \$316,275,146. He reported total fiscal year revenues of \$37,776,561, total fiscal year expenditures of \$19,952,500 for a net profit for the fiscal year of \$17,824,061. Motion by Cliff Dressel and seconded by Michael Thibodeaux to receive the financial reports. **Motion carried.**

APPLICATION FOR BENEFITS: **(On file in office)** After reviewing the applications for benefits, Robby Barousse moved that the applications be approved. Motion seconded by Gary Loftin. **Motion carried.**

REFUNDS: (Attachment 2) Debbie reported that \$107,117 had been refunded to members in June with a total of \$1,086,398 for the fiscal year. She further reported \$80,927 had been refunded in the month of July.

COMMENTS BY INVESTMENT CONSULTANT: (Attachment 3)

Kari Creighton informed the Board that two money managers would be presenting their proposals on Hedge Funds today and distributed a Returns & Standard Deviation Comparison Report between the two managers and the current manager Froley Revy.

John McCormick, Vice President and Head of Business Strategy with Blackstone Alternative Asset Management presented their proposal. (Report on file in office)

John Stimpson, Director, Institutional Services Group, and Christopher Ito, Managing Director and Head of Risk Management, with UBP Asset Management presented their proposal. (Report on file in office)

After hearing the proposals of the money managers, Cliff Dressel moved that Louisiana Clerks of Court Retirement and Relief Fund hire UBP Asset Management to invest in Hedge Funds, as proposed by Investment Consultant Kari Creighton, by transferring thirty million dollars from Froley Revy with all expedience and with the transition to be facilitated through Northern Trust, subject to the contract approval by Attorney Randy Zinna. Motion seconded by Hart Bourque. **Motion carried.**

Kari further recommended that the Board delay investing in Core Plus Funds with Pyramis for the time being due to the credit issues in the market. Cliff Dressel moved that the Board give Kari authority to postpone the investment in Pyramis until she felt it feasible to do so. Motion seconded by Ann Ardoin. **Motion carried.**

COMMENT BY ACTUARY: Gary Curran informed the Board that he would be giving a presentation on a Back Drop proposal for the 2008 at the Clerks' Only meeting in December. He also presented the concept of possibly reducing the 8% target ratio in the future if it were feasible. The Board was in agreement with the actuary pursuing that concept.

OTHER BUSINESS: (On file in office) Gary Loftin moved that the Board pass a resolution adopting the System Survey and Compliance Questionnaire as presented. Motion seconded by Hart Bourque. **Motion carried.**

Debbie presented a copy of Act 78 which was passed by the Sheriffs' Retirement and Relief Fund that provided for advance education for candidates for membership of their Board of Trustees. (Attachment 4)

Debbie presented a copy of letter from Representative Pete Schneider thanking the Board and Staff for their cooperation and assistance during the 2007 Regular Legislative Session.

Additionally, she reported that a final notice had been sent to the Disability Retiree that had not sent her annual report and had also spoken to her by phone and had instructed her to simply file the affidavit, but it had not been received at this time.

She further reported that Vera Harrell would be retiring on September 1, 2007, and that she was in the process of trying to fill that position.

21	(d) Four hours of professional development in investment strategies.
