Student with the highest dollar amount raised in grades PK-1 = Kidzone DIY Racer

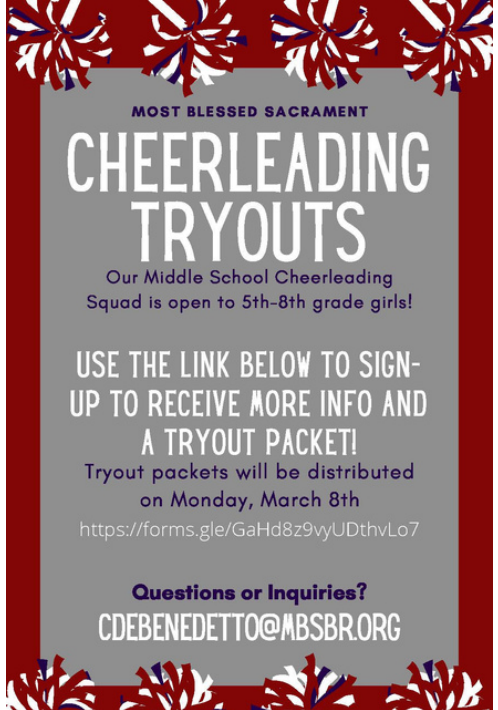
Student with the highest dollar amount raised in grades 2&3 = Hoverboard + GoKart

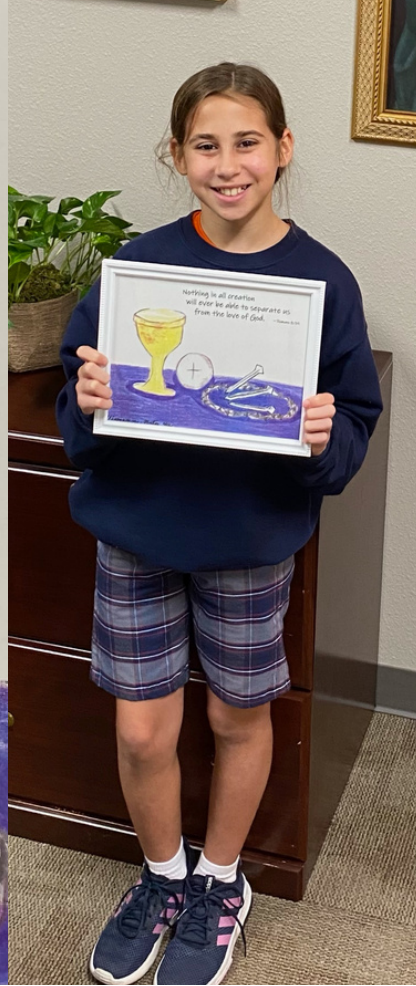
