For math IXLs, students are to complete 200 minutes throughout the summer (about 25-30 minutes a week). Each module the students choose from the list should be completed to 80%. Modules with a lower accuracy than 80% will not be counted. The IXLs listed come from the grade level the students just completed to keep those skills strong before moving on in August. IXLs need to be complete by July 31st to give us time to graduate students to their next grade in the IXL system. Students new to MBS for the 2021-2022 school year are not required to complete math IXLs.





We invite everyone to attend a building & development meeting regarding the vision of Most Blessed Sacrament Church Parish and the current buildings we have been publizing about at the church.


Come listen to members of the MBS

#### What have we been up to?

- The gym floor is being replaced and the gym walls painted. New scoreboard is being installed.
- All homeroom classrooms are being fully renovated with new paint, cabinet facings, Formica countertops, baseboards, ceiling grids and tiles, LED lighting, insulation, doorknobs, and storage.

Child Protection credentials allow the holder of these credentials the opportunity to chaperone/volunteer at MBS School. All credentialed adults must abide by the sign-up and confirmation process for each event.

# Talent Update Lime

#### The following change has been made to the Parent/Student Handbook regarding Time & Talent (aka Service Hours):

**Parent's Commitment to Church and School** One of the requirements for enrollment and/or retention at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School is a commitment to the following agreement.

- In addition to daily prayer at home, the Catholic members of our family will attend Mass every weekend and on Holy Days of Obligation.
- Twenty (20) hours of Time and Talent will be given to the school and/or Church each year. Hours must be completed between January 1 and December 31 to receive the in-parish tuition rate. These hours are reviewed each year.
- A minimum amount of \$325.00 will be donated to the Church to support the stewardship program as an Identified Offertory Giver (IOG). IOGs will receive in-parish tuition. Donations will be verified by December 15 unless otherwise authorized by the Pastor. Any offerings thereafter will count towards the following school year.

#### Definition of an Hour

One (1) hour is defined as an actual hour of volunteer work or donation purchases of \$10.

#### **New Students Clause**

Time and Talent hours are prorated for new students. However, new families must still meet the IOG requirement of \$325.00 to receive in-parish tuition.

#### Log your Service Hours into FACTS.

Go to Family > Family Home.
You will see "Service Hours" in
the middle of the screen. Click
"add" to add the hours. You
must type in a description.
Select "type a custom value,"
and then type your description.

#### **Sending Items to School**

Please label your items that you send to school from a SignUp Genius:

- Parent Name (signed up on the SUG)
- Name of item
- Title of Sign Up (ex: 5th Grade Auction Basket)

This helps us match your hours in FACTS.
