



Dear Parents:

October 24-31 is Red Ribbon Week. During Red Ribbon Week, we participate in a national campaign focusing on positive, healthy choices to remain drug-free. October is also National Bullying Prevention Month. Red Ribbon Week will include lessons and messages to put a stop to bullying.

Our theme this year is "Team up against drugs and bullying!" The week will be filled with activities and treats, however, dress-up days, pencils, and prizes don't change behavior. It takes a real partnership between school and family to increase awareness and reinforce positive decisions. Here are some ways you as parents can help keep your children safe and drug-free:

- 1. Talk to your children about your rules and expectations often, not just one time.
- 2. Take advantage of ads, shows, songs, and other media to help you introduce the topics of drug use and bullying in a natural, unforced way.
- 3. Be a good listener and be honest when answering their questions.
- 4. Don't react to their questions or comments in a negative way that will cut off further discussion.
- 5. Model safe, healthy choices and kind, respectful behavior.
- 6. Supervise, supervise, supervise! Fact: Children are most likely to experiment with drugs between 4-6 PM. If children are supervised, experimentation is much less likely.
- 7. Spend screen-free time with your family, particularly around the dinner table. Research shows that quality family meal time correlates with healthier, positive life choices and overall success.

We look forward to a great Red Ribbon Week! As the week progresses, ask your children about our activities, such as the high school and college level coaches and team presentations. We will also have one "dress up" day. On October 26th, MBS will participate in Wear Red and/or MBS Jersey Day. Your children can wear red shirts, red socks, and other red accessories, with their uniform bottoms. If your children have a fall sport MBS jersey, they are encouraged to wear it that day, too!

As an act of kindness (which decreases bullying), middle schoolers will be reading picture books about friendship to grades PK-4 throughout the week. You can be part of the TEAM by donating to our week's festivities as an act of kindness and to help make it a WINNING week! 



Registration for school Basketball is now open!

Deadline is Sunday, October 9 at 11:45pm. No exceptions.

- 3rd-5th grade is considered developmental basketball.
- 6th-8th grade is considered JV and Varsity basketball.
- There will be a boys' basketball tryout/evaluation on October 26 in the MBS School gym. Time slots will be assigned per grade level and sent out at a later date. All boys participating in boys' basketball MUST attend the tryout/evaluation.
- Practices will begin the week of November 7, 2022.
- Seasons
 - Developmental: December 5th-February 5th
 - JV and Varsity basketball: January 4th-March 3rd (Jamborees will be December 14th, 15th, 16th)
- The registration fee includes the use of an MBS team uniform, a shooting shirt (which may be kept by the player), and all diocesan and CSAA fees to join the league.

Time & Talent (Service Hours

Parent's Commitment to Church and School One of the requirements for enrollment and/or retention at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School is a commitment to the following agreement.

- In addition to daily prayer at home, the Catholic members of our family will attend Mass every weekend and on Holy Days of Obligation.
- Twenty (20) hours of Time and Talent will be given to the school and/or Church each year. Hours must be completed between January 1 and December 31 to receive the in-parish tuition rate. These hours are reviewed each year.
- A minimum amount of \$325.00 will be donated to the Church to support the stewardship program as an Identified Offertory Giver (IOG). IOGs will receive in-parish tuition. Donations will be verified by December 15 unless otherwise authorized by the Pastor. Any offerings thereafter will count towards the following school year.

Definition of an Hour

One (1) hour is defined as an actual hour of volunteer work or donation purchases of \$10.

New Students Clause

Time and Talent hours are prorated for new students. However, new families must still meet the IOG requirement of \$325.00 to receive in-parish tuition.
