- Please create a name tag with the Saint's name, as well as your child's grade on *it*. We will line up the children by grade level for the procession into Church.
- A **GROUP PHOTO** will be taken at the end of Mass and parents will be able to take a photo, ٠ too.
- After Mass, you must help your child change into their school uniform, and then bring them back to school, directly to their classroom (no need to check in the office).
