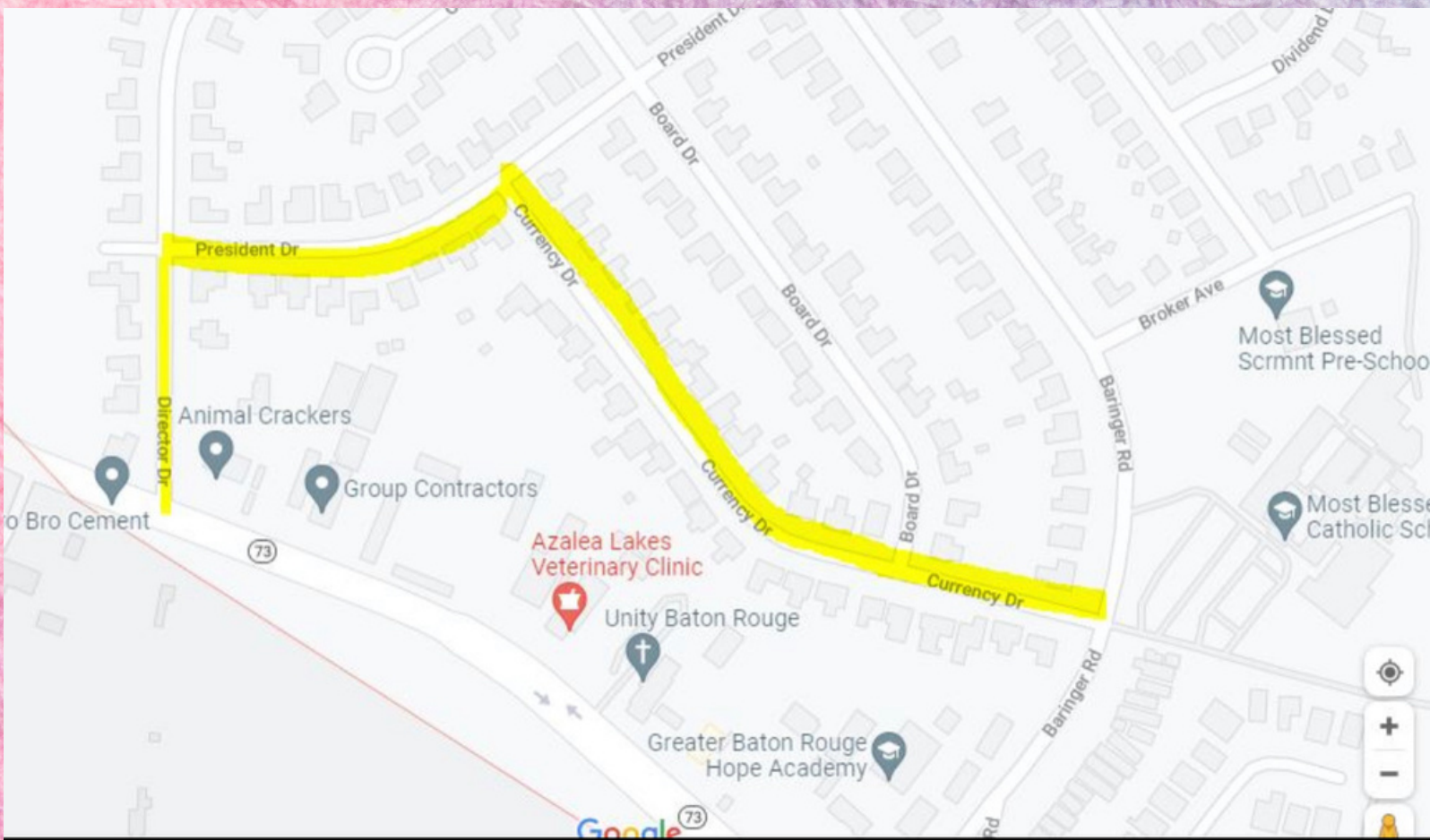

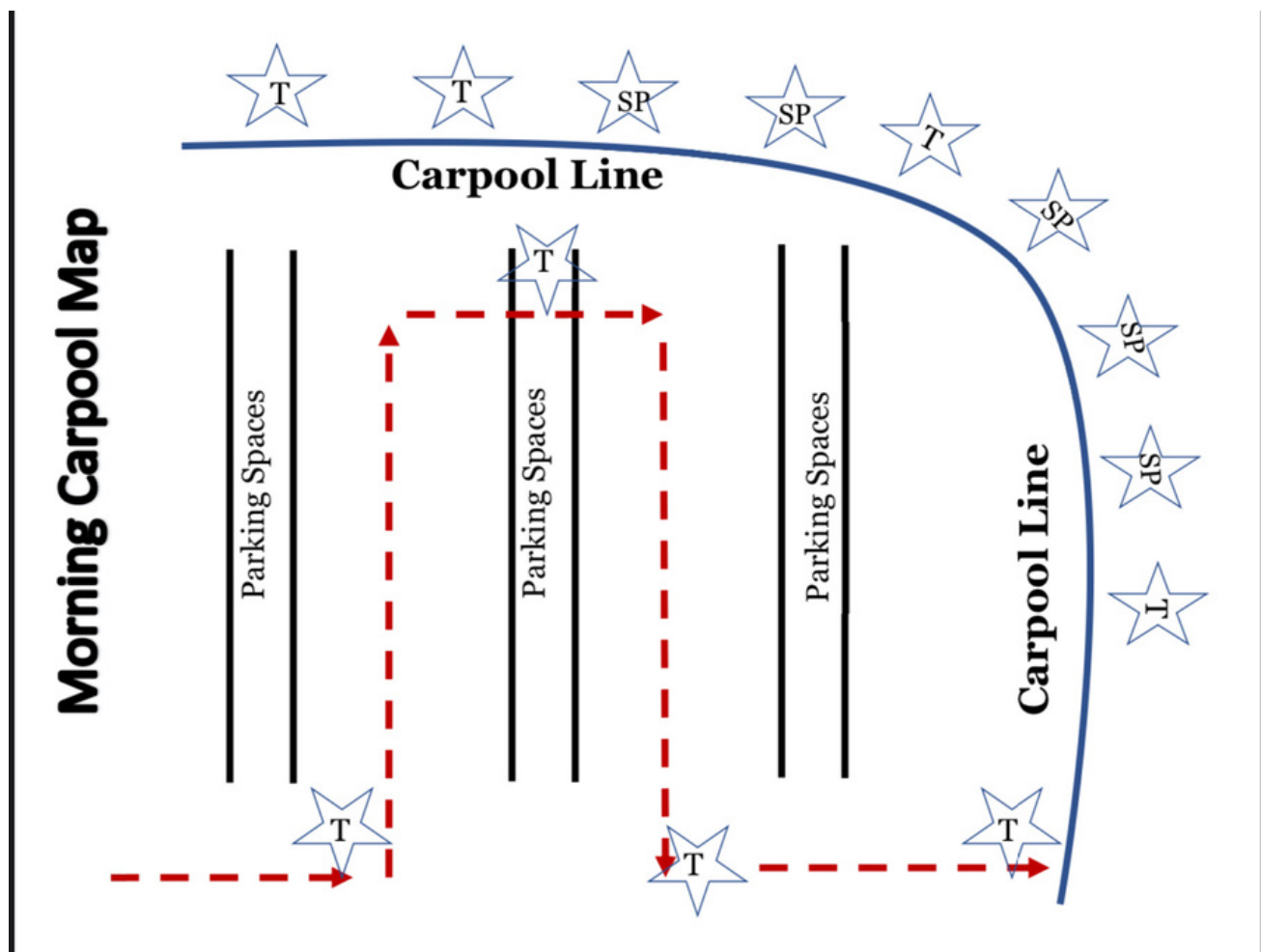
Since we will begin setting up the Fairgrounds next week, we must adjust the way our "normal" carpool runs in both the morning and afternoon. The map below will help you understand the written instructions on the next two pages.



AM & PM Carpool Instructions for Tuesday, October 11–Monday, October 17

Morning Carpool

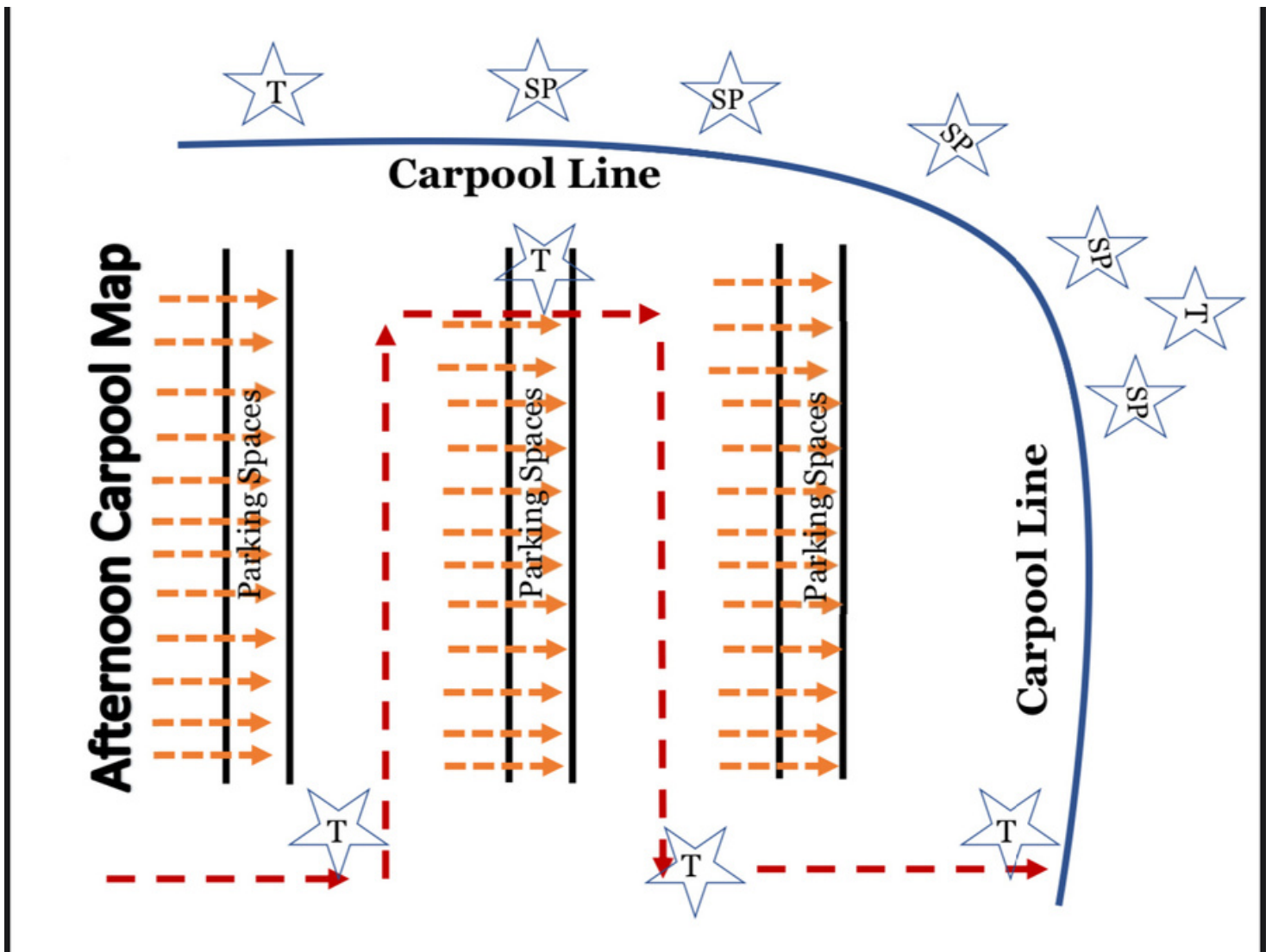
- From Jefferson Hwy, turn onto **Director** by Animal Crackers Learning Center. *DO NOT Turn into the Church Parking lot.*
- Continue on Director and turn right on **President**.
- Turn right onto **Currency**. This road will feed directly into the school parking lot entrance.
- Cross **Baringer Rd** and enter the school parking lot. (Please be sure to wait on Currency if the lot is full. We do not want to block Baringer from the buses or those exiting carpool.)
- Enter the second row of the parking lot and begin following the cones to snake through the parking lot. Faculty will be there to direct you.
- At the last set of parking spaces, you will enter the carpool line.
- Please be sure that your child is unbuckled and ready to exit the vehicle when you reach the Teacher or Safety Patrol student.
- Exit the school parking lot as you normally would for carpool.



AM & PM Carpool Instructions for Tuesday, October 11–Monday, October 17

Afternoon Carpool

- From Jefferson Hwy, turn onto **Director** by Animal Crackers Learning Center. *DO NOT Turn into the Church Parking lot.*
- Continue on Director and turn right on **President**.
- Turn right onto **Currency**. This road will feed directly into the school parking lot entrance.
- Cross **Baringer Rd** and enter the school parking lot. (Please be sure to wait on Currency if the lot is full. We do not want to block Baringer from the buses or those exiting carpool.)
- Follow the cones through the parking lot and follow the teacher's directions to enter the parking spaces.
- Pull in to the parking spot so that you are facing the carpool line and can drive forward to enter the line.
- A teacher will then enter your Car Rider Pro tag number. All tags should be displayed on the rearview mirror and visible for the teacher to see.
- On the teacher's motion enter the carpool line and proceed as normal.
- Exit the school parking lot as you normally would for carpool.

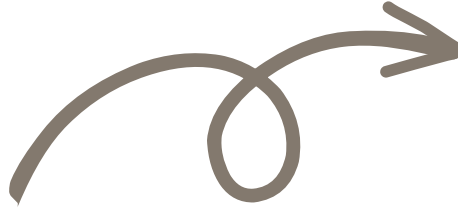

Children should be dropped off in St. Ursula Hall on the MBS school campus; parents will meet in the MBS school cafeteria



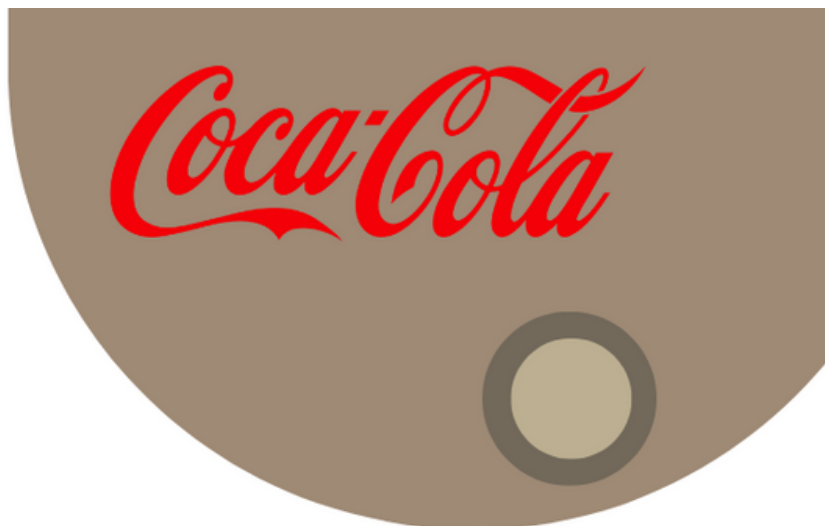
Join 4-H Today!

Is your child interested in character work, monologues, auditioning for film and stage, acting in all capacities, or need any extra help strengthening their performance skills?

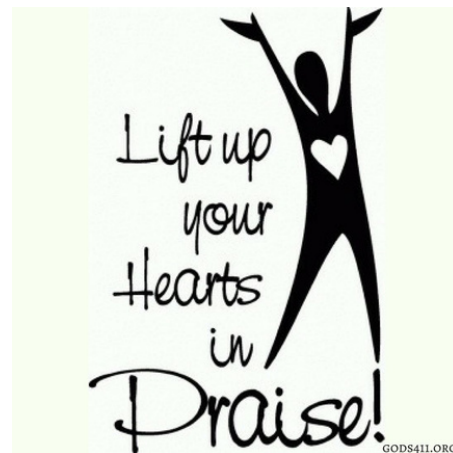
Our Drama teacher Ms. Emily is now offering one-on-one acting lessons after school!

Each session will be 2 hours on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 3:30-5:30pm and 5:30-7:30pm.

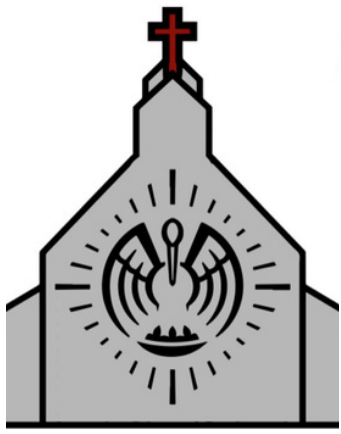

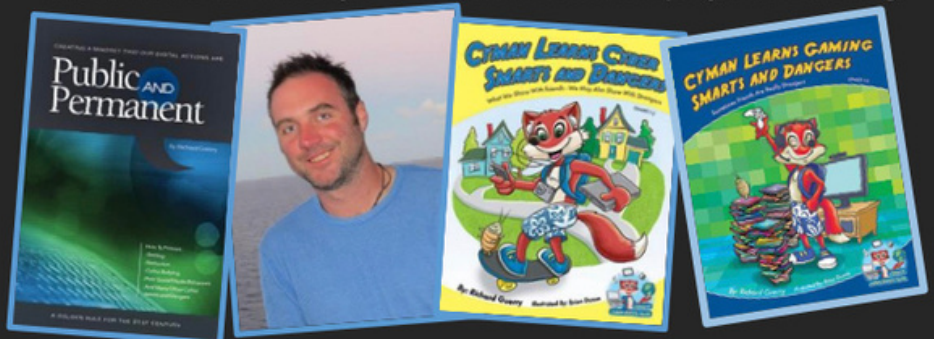

Time & Talent (Service Hours)

Parent's Commitment to Church and School One of the requirements for enrollment and/or retention at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School is a commitment to the following agreement.

- In addition to daily prayer at home, the Catholic members of our family will attend Mass every weekend and on Holy Days of Obligation.
- Twenty (20) hours of Time and Talent will be given to the school and/or Church each year. Hours must be completed between January 1 and December 31 to receive the in-parish tuition rate. These hours are reviewed each year.
- A minimum amount of \$325.00 will be donated to the Church to support the stewardship program as an Identified Offertory Giver (IOG). IOGs will receive in-parish tuition. Donations will be verified by December 15 unless otherwise authorized by the Pastor. Any offerings thereafter will count towards the following school year.

Definition of an Hour

One (1) hour is defined as an actual hour of volunteer work or donation purchases of \$10.

New Students Clause

Time and Talent hours are prorated for new students. However, new families must still meet the IOG requirement of \$325.00 to receive in-parish tuition.

Log your Service Hours into FACTS.

Go to Family > Family Home. You will see "Service Hours" in the middle of the screen. Click "add" to add the hours. You must type in a description. Select "type a custom value," and then type your description.

Please label your items that you send to school from a SignUp Genius:

- **Parent Name (signed up on the SUG)**
