Why: Children have access to the internet through televisions, I-pads, games, and phones. It is not only likely but probable that your child has encountered questionable content and/or participated in questionable content. MBS uses BARK as a tool to monitor the online use of our students. While some of the reports received happen during school hours, the majority happen at home with students using their school email address. We wanted to share some of the statistics to highlight that inappropriate use of the internet affects all ages and all grades.

What are You doing this Summer?

Announcing our *1st Annual MBS~ELC Lil Pelicans Summer Camp!* Seven weeks of quality care and fun-filled activities in our faith-based Summer Camp. Your child will enjoy daily activities in Art, Music, and Religion along with interesting community visitors and special group activities. Parents can choose a 9 AM - 3 PM option alone or add an Extended Day with Early Drop Off (EDO) beginning at 7 AM and/or a Late Pick Up (LPU) until 5 PM. Priority will be given to currently enrolled students. Children ages 2-6 entering 1st grade will be accepted.

Summer Camp will be set up as two blocks. Block 1 will run from June 5 - June 30. Block 2 will run from July 3 - July 21st. Parents can register for either block #1 or #2 or combine both blocks(1 & 2) for the whole summer. Parents choosing both blocks (1 & 2) will receive a 10% discount on Registration Fees and pay only \$270.

If you will be sending a qualifying sibling, contact the office for additional forms. <u>At this time all **currently**</u> **<u>enrolled</u>** families can opt to defer the Registration Fee payment until February 28th, 2023</u>. The returned form alone will hold your child's seat for Summer Camp. Registration Fees should be paid no later than February 28th. NOTE: *All tuition and fees associated with Summer Camp will not be drafted and shall be paid in full by check or cash prior to the start of each block*.

These ladies have been hard at work preparing for an exciting, fun-filled Summer Camp experience for our children. **Parent's Commitment to Church and School** One of the requirements for enrollment and/or retention at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School is a commitment to the following agreement.

- In addition to daily prayer at home, the Catholic members of our family will attend Mass every weekend and on Holy Days of Obligation.
- Twenty (20) hours of Time and Talent will be given to the school and/or Church each year. Hours must be completed between January 1 and December 31 to receive the in-parish tuition rate. These hours are reviewed each year.
- <u>A minimum amount of \$325.00 will be donated t</u>o the Church to support the stewardship program as an Identified Offertory Giver (IOG). IOGs will receive in-parish tuition. <u>Donations will be verified by December 15</u> unless otherwise authorized by the Pastor. Any offerings thereafter will count towards the following school year.

### Definition of an Hour

One (1) hour is defined as an actual hour of volunteer work or donation purchases of \$10.

### New Students Clause

Time and Talent hours are prorated for new students. However, new families must still meet the IOG requirement of \$325.00 to receive in-parish tuition.

### Log your Service Hours into FACTS.

Go to Family > Family Home. You will see "Service Hours" in the middle of the screen. Click "add" to add the hours. You must type in a description. Select "type a custom value," and then type your description.


