

# Summer Math IXL

## Outgoing 5<sup>th</sup> Grade/Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

All 2022-2023 MBS students returning for the 2023-2024 school year should complete the assigned IXL skills. Students should complete the skills to a score of 80. Students should complete the entire list or spend 5 hours over the course of summer - whichever is least. These are the skills students learned in the 2022-2023 school year and will prepare them for the 2023-2024 school year. Students will receive an assessment grade in the first nine weeks for their Summer IXL participation. Students who do not complete Summer IXL will receive a zero. Students new to MBS for the 2023-2024 school year will be exempt from this assignment. We will get new students IXL accounts as soon as possible.
