Our annual celebration to remember the Feasts of All Saints & All Souls will take place on **Friday, November 1, 2024, with Mass at 8:15 am**. During Mass, we would like to highlight the Communion of Saints by inviting students in grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> to dress as their patron or favorite Saint of the Church in **simple costumes worn over their school dress uniforms**. They will walk in the opening procession, as the Litany of Saints is sung.

**If your child would like to participate in the event:**

- Complete the Permission/Commitment Form below and **return it to your child’s religion teacher, Ms. Cochran no later than Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup>**.
- **Your child will need to come to school already dressed in SIMPLE costumes** ... not elaborate outfits that will be too warm to wear or so complicated that the message of the Saints’ simple lives will be lost to our students. (Please note: my office will not be able to assist with costumes.) **They will walk over to Church with their class and homeroom teacher.**
- Please **create a name tag with the Saint’s name, as well as your child’s grade on it**. We will line up the children by grade level for the procession into Church.
- A **GROUP PHOTO** will be taken at the end of Mass and parents will be able to take a photo, too.
- **After Mass, your child will walk back to school with their class as usual, remove their costume once in their homeroom and store it in their locker.**
