Upcoming Charges on FACTS account

- Due to accounting, all fees will no longer be dispersed over 11 months with tuition, but will be withdrawn at Enrollment. Enrollment takes place in January of each year. As a reminder, there is no tuition deducted in January.
- Effective January 2025, all 2025-2026 fees will be due at enrollment. In January, the following 25-26 fees will be drafted:
 - **Enrollment fee \$375.** After the enrollment deadline, the enrollment fee increases to \$475 per student for returning students.
 - **Technology fee of \$275.** This fee is assessed to students to cover all technology, which not only applies to the cost of student chrome books, but also to online textbooks licenses, subscriptions to ClassLink and all its components.
 - **Security fee of \$275.** This fee is applied to families to staff a Baton Rouge Sherriff Office deputy on campus from 6am to 6pm while the students are present.
 - **Facts fee of \$55.** A Facts payment plan must be set up during enrollment process.
 - **Capital Maintenance Fee of \$400** per family if applicable. This fee is assessed to families who are not identified offertory givers of MBS Church, those who are registered at another church parish, and/or those who are non-Catholic.
- *Please reference Mrs. Gioe's email that was sent on Friday, December 13 about the deadline for these fees.*
- The PK - First Grade Fee and the 8th Grade Class Fee will be drafted with the first tuition payment for the 2025-2026 school year, which will be in June of 2025.

Enrollment for 2025-2026 school year: January 9-17

Existing Kindergarten - 7th grade Students

- All students (K-7) who will remain at MBS for the 2025-26 school year must "Re-enroll" through FACTS Family Portal.
- If your student will not return, please select "unenroll"
- Re-enrollment takes place January 9-17. This function will not be active until these dates.
- The fee is \$375. After the 17th, a \$100 late fee will be added. The enrollment fee is non-refundable.
- Tuition is not deducted in January.
- Have your FACTS login information. Reminder: District Code is MBS-LA.
 - Login to FACTS Family Portal
 - Click Apply/Enroll>Enrollment/Reenrollment
 - Begin the reenrollment process
- *Spirit Shirt sizes are communicated for the upcoming school year during Re-Enrollment.*

Existing PK Students

- PK students who applied to Kindergarten in November will be notified of acceptance on February 14.
- February 17-March 3, accepted students will be asked to "Enroll" in FACTS.
- Enrollment fee is \$375 and is non-refundable. At this time, the other fees as mentioned above will be charged also.

Scholarship Pajama Day

Student Council is collecting \$2 per student on Monday, January 6. Those students who bring a minimum of \$2 are able to wear Pajamas to school. This money goes towards the Jill Peno Memorial Scholarship and the Home and School Angel Scholarship, both honor MBS students whom we have lost before their 8th grade graduation. No slippers or flip flops. Pajamas must be modest and appropriate. Students with inappropriate pajamas must call home for a uniform. Students must wear athletic shoes.

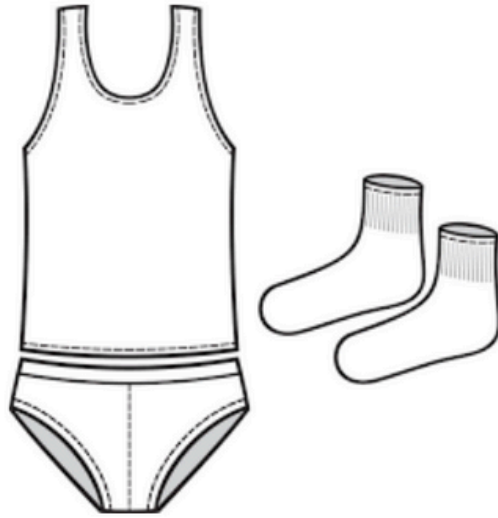

Volunteerism - Time & Talent

- In order to volunteer on school or church campus, you must go through the Office of Child Protection to update your credentials.
- Opportunities to volunteer and get service hours will be placed here in the newsletter.

OFFICE OF CHILD PROTECTION

According to the Safe Environment Policy promulgated by the Diocese of Baton Rouge, all parish and school ministry volunteers/chaperones must complete a mandatory background check and child protection training. Child Protection credentials allow the holder of these credentials the opportunity to chaperone/volunteer.

All credentialed adults must abide by the sign-up and confirmation process for each event.

Update Your Volunteer File

Please note that the Code of Ethics and the Chaperone and Volunteer Requirements Agreement must be reviewed by all volunteers of MBS School annually as required by the Diocese of Baton Rouge. Please complete and submit the Code of Ethics Acknowledgement form, page 5, and the Agreement form to the MBS Office of Child Protection to update your file.

Time & Talent (Service Hours)

Parent's Commitment to Church and School

Enrollment and/or continued enrollment at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School requires a commitment to ALL of the following:

- **Prayer and Mass** – Families must commit to daily prayer at home. Catholic families must attend weekly, Sunday, Mass on Holy Days of Obligation. Non-Catholic families must attend Sunday services at their home church.
- **Service** - Twenty (20) hours of Time and Talent given to the school and/or Church each year. Hours must be completed between January 1 and December 31 *to receive the in-parish tuition rate*. These hours are reviewed each year.

Definition of an hour of Time and Talent: an actual hour of volunteer work or donation purchases of \$10

- **Weekly Church Offering** – As an Identified Offertory Giver (IOG), a minimum amount of \$325.00 must be donated, yearly, to the Most Blessed Sacrament General Offertory or Building Fund to support the Church stewardship program. Church members who meet the IOG requirement *will receive in-parish tuition*. Donations will be verified by December 15 unless otherwise authorized by the Pastor or Principal. Any offerings thereafter will count towards the next school year.

New Students Clause

Time and Talent hours are prorated for new students. However, new families must still meet the IOG requirement of \$325.00 to receive in-parish tuition.

Log your Service Hours into FACTS.

Go to Family > Family Home. You will see "Service Hours" in the middle of the screen. Click "add" to add the hours. You must type in a description. Select "type a custom value," and then type your description.

Sending Items to School

Please label your items that you send to school from a SignUp Genius:

- Parent Name (signed up on the SUG)
- Name of item
- Title of Sign Up (ex: 5th Grade Auction Basket)

This helps us match your hours in FACTS.
