Dress Code for Spirit Shirt Days:

- Boys in grades Pre-K-8 may wear Class Spirit Shirt with approved uniform bottoms.

- In cold weather, regulation sweatshirt, jacket/coat must be worn.

REVISED CHILD PROTECTION POLICIES UPDATE FOR CURRENT FILES EXTENDED



The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops revised the child protection policies. Please note that all volunteers that have a child protection file must update their file with the revised forms in order to maintain their child protection credentials.

Child protection files that are not updated <u>will be closed</u> during the database sweep. The sweep of the database has been postponed for a few weeks. There is no set date for the sweep, so please update your file now.

The update consists of the revised Code of Ethics (12-31-2019) and the online child protection training certificate for Serving Vulnerable Populations. See attachments below for more information on updating.

The Chaperone and Volunteer Requirements Agreement 2020-2021 has been <u>attached</u> for your convenience. Please mark the 2020-2021 grade level of each child in the Class section.
