

Fees


The fee to participate in CSAA basketball and volleyball is \$100. This fee will include the warm-up shirt and uniform usuage.

During the Corona quarantine, I found myself needing some positivity, so I began participating in a group called The Catholic Moms Community. We often say that children do not come with an instruction manual; however, we can look to our Catholic faith for instruction and guidance.

"Catholicism is genius!

- Receiving Christ at least once a week = treat others how Jesus would treat you
- Mass = sacrifice and spending time being a piece of the whole; community

I might be over-simplifying and I know there are far more deeper meanings than my simple thoughts, but this is my way of meeting people at that entrance."

- Trinity = God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit is always with us
- Fasting = Reminds us of how fortunate we are
- Service = To be the hands and feet of Christ for others
