
American Covers provides turnkey solutions including seating, flooring, lighting, fencing and plant safety certi-fied installation crews.

SAFETY AFFILIATIONS



American Covers Inc. employees are routinely trained to comply with plant safety requirements and hold current OSHA, Plant Specific and TWIC certifications.

SAFETY CREDENTIALS

American Covers field installers hold the following safety credentials: Transportation Workers Identification Credential (T.W.I.C.), O.S.H.A. Basic Plus and numerous plant site specifics. Our field installers receive their continuous safety training and site specifics through the following organizations: Gulf Coast Safety Council (G.C.S.C.) Houston Area Safety Council (H.A.S.C.), Safety Council of Southwest Louisiana (S.W.L.A.), International Safety Training Council (I.S.T.C.)

SAFETY AFFILIATES

American Covers Inc. is a member of the following safety verification organizations. ISNetworld, Avetta, and PEC's. These industries recognized organizations, collect self-reported conformance information from vendors, verify its accuracy, and then report the results in an easy to follow dashboard format.

DRUG SCREENING

American Covers employees are active members of DISA drug testing consortium and comply with random drug and alcohol screening requirements. Employees are tested for pre-employment, random, post-accident and reasonable suspicion.

BACKGROUND SCREENING

All American Covers field installers are required to consent to a background screening process. The background screenings are through DISA, First Advantage or I.T.S.C. The employee background screening services provide the most current and accurate data available and gives each client the ability to order and track employee background screens online.
