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**How do we Affirm Trust In God's Power To Save?**

**1. Notice The Self-Absorbed Enemy & The Self-Absorbed Inner-Me - Psalm 3:1-2,** 1 Lord, how they have increased who trouble me! Many are they who rise up against me. 2 Many are they who say of me, "There is no help for him in God."

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**Question for Dialogue -** What makes it difficult to recognize attacks from either external enemies or the internal "inner-me?"

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**2. Realize God Protects & Gives Us Confidence - Psalm 3:3,** 3 But You, O Lord, are a shield for me, My glory and the One who lifts up my head.

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**Question for Dialogue:** Why is it so hard to realize that many of our present challenges and tests are God's way of preparing us for upcoming seasons of difficulties?

**3. Pray To Access God's Power - Psalm 3:4,** 4 I cried to the Lord with my voice, And He heard me from His holy hill.

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**4. Meditate On God's Provision For Peaceful Sleep - Psalm 3:5-7,** 5 I lay down and slept; I awoke, for the Lord sustained me. 6 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people Who have set themselves against me all around. 7 Arise, O Lord; Save me, O my God! For You have struck all my enemies on the cheekbone; You have broken the teeth of the ungodly.

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**Question for Dialogue:** Why do we often neglect to remember those past seasons of God delivering us through hard times?

**5. Embrace God's Power to Save - Psalm 3:8,** 8 Salvation belongs to the Lord. Your blessing is upon Your people.

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
