How do you know that **Camaraderie In Prayer Ignites Confidence In God's Power To Win?**

1. See The Prayer Warrior's Request - Psalm 20:1-4, NKJV, 1 May the Lord answer you in the day of trouble; May the name of the God of Jacob defend you; 2 May He send you help from the sanctuary, And strengthen you out of Zion; 3 May He remember all your offerings, And accept your burnt sacrifice. 4 May He grant you according to your heart's desire, And fulfill all your purpose.

Question For Dialogue: We shy away from being vulnerable with prayer warriors because we fear being misunderstood, judged, and not supported. Yet, what are some things we can do to help overcome these fears and open up to prayer warriors, who deeply care for us?

2. See The Prayer Warrior's Confidence - Psalm 20:5, NKJV, 5 We will rejoice in your salvation, And in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all your petitions.

Question For Dialogue: What does a failure to surrender to God's will on a matter reveal about our heart?

3. See The Prayer Recipient's Confidence - Psalm 20:6-8, NKJV, 6 Now I know that the Lord saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven With the saving strength of His right hand. 7 Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of the Lord our God. 8 They have bowed down and fallen; But we have risen and stand upright.

Question For Dialogue: Have you personally experienced God in any of his listed character traits? If so, how and what did that do for your confidence?
