### Principles to Keep God's Promises

This past Sunday, I preached a sermon entitled "The Importance of Trusting in God" based from the Scripture of *Proverbs 3:5-6*. Even though we know it is God's desire that we trust Him in all things, the sad reality is many of us as Believers first trust in other people or other things before we truly trust God and his promises. In tonight's lesson, let's look at some biblical Principles to Keep God's Promises.

- 1. You must spend time with God.** *Matthew 14:22-23*  
The closer you are to God, the further you are from the enemy.
- 2. You must spend time in God's Word.** *Psalms 119:9-10*  
The Bible will give you strength, inspiration, and instruction.
- 3. You must memorize God's Word.** *Joshua 1:8*  
Memorizing scripture will help you to stand against the enemies attacks.
- 4. You must spend time in prayer.** *Philippians 4:6-7*  
Prayer is our direct line of communication with God.
- 5. You must put on and keep on your spiritual armor.** *Ephesians 6:10-17*
- 6. You must learn from the mistakes of others.** *1st Corinthians 10:1-12*
- 7. You must fellowship with other Believers.** *Ecclesiastes 4:9-10*  
No Christian is expected to be a lone ranger.
- 8. You must remember God's track record.** *Joshua 21:43-45*  
Do not forget all that God has already done.
- 9. You must realize that no Believer is exempt from falling.** *1st John 1:10*  
The enemy has gotten the best of us to fall.
- 10. You must repent and ask for forgiveness when you fall.** *1st John 1:8-9*  
Forgiveness is available when we do fall.

Brothers and Sisters, if we expect to trust God and His promises, we must commit ourselves to these principles.
