*Micah 7:5-7*

1. Pain – How it hurts.
2. Pity – Inadequate support from others (family, friends and church).
3. Problem – Inability to let go or move on.
4. Purpose – Spiritual attacks by the enemy to keep us living defeated.
5. Plan – Deliverance, freedom and moving forward.
