Topic: Lessons From Jesus
Chapters: Luke 17 - 19 February 9th, 2022

Central Text: Luke 17:19, NKJV, 19 And He said to Him, “Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well.”

1. We Have A Duty of Service to God - Luke 17:10, NKJV, 10 So likewise you, when you have done all those things which you are commanded, say, ‘We are unprofitable servants. We have done what was our duty to do.’ ”

Luke 17:17, NKJV, 17 So Jesus answered and said, “Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? **Luke 17:16, NKJV, 16** and fell down on his face at His feet (see the humility), giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

God is the Potter & We are the Clay - Jeremiah 18:4, NKJV, 4 And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter; so he made it again into another vessel, as it seemed good to the potter to make.

2. Persistence Requires Faith - Luke 18:8, NKJV, 8 Jesus declares “8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?”

- A persistent widow had an earthly king to respond to her

Question for Dialogue: In addition to not having faith, why do people quit on God and begin to live according to their own lifestyle?

3. Surrendering Control To Jesus Is Essential - Luke 18:22-23, NKJV, 22 So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, “You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.” **23** But when he heard this, he became very sorrowful, for he was very rich.

Question for Dialogue: How would you define spiritual blindness?

Question for Personal Reflection: What’s going on in your life right now that you need to implement faith for?
