Topic: Connect The Dots To Reveal Jesus
Chapters: Luke 24 February 23rd, 2022

Central Text: Luke 24:27, NKJV, 27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

Before we get into the final chapter of Luke, let's look at some of the prophetic dots from the Old Testament that point to Jesus:

Moses: Deuteronomy 18:15-18, NKJV, **Psalmist David:** Psalm 16:27, NKJV, **Psalmist David:** Psalm 22:1-23, NKJV
Prophet Isaiah: Isaiah 9:6-7, NKJV, **Prophet Isaiah:** Isaiah 53, NKJV

1. Believe What Is Revealed - Read and Expound Luke 24:1-27, NKJV

Question for Dialogue: Have you ever had signs from Jesus or the Holy Spirit to do something and believed the signs, and then benefited from acting on your beliefs?

Those disciples and apostles who believed - consistently quoted old testament prophecies in their sermons to preach repentance, forgiveness of sins, and belief in a resurrected Messiah.

Peter - Taught from Psalm 16:10 in Acts 2:27-33, **Philip** - Taught from Isaiah 53 in Acts 8:30-40, **Paul** - Taught from Psalm 2:7 in Acts 13:30-33

2. Pay Attention To Jesus' Strategic & Intentional Moves - Read and Expound Luke 24:28-43

Question For Dialogue: Romans 8:28, NKJV And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose. **Have you ever discovered in the middle of a difficult season or soon after the difficulty, why God allowed you to go through it? If so, would anyone like to explain?**

Here's a Rhetorical Question for you, Just for Thought. Has there been a repetitive message you consistently hear from God, and the Lord is saying you can't move forward and experience peace until you receive and act on this message from me?

3. Tell Others What We Know About Jesus, The Holy Spirit, & The Joy of The Lord - Read and Expound: Luke 24:44-53

When all of the Dots are Connected, we can then reveal a Picture of the Love of Christ.

Question for Dialogue: What are some things that can help us become intentional about sharing Jesus?
