WHO WE SELECT

Applicants must complete and submit the FABC High School Graduate Scholarship Application and must:

1. Be a baptized (according to the Baptist faith) member on the FABC membership roll for at least 12 months by the time the scholarship is awarded.
2. Have an OFFICIAL high school transcript mailed to FABC New Orleans and postmarked by the deadline. Transcripts may not be hand-carried or delivered by students, parents or anyone else.
3. Submit a copy of an acceptance letter from an **accredited** college, university or vocational technical school which you will be attending.
4. Submit the High School Teacher Recommendation Form: This form must be completed by either your eleventh (11th) or twelfth (12th) grade teacher who taught you. It may not be completed by a school administrator unless the administrator serves or served as the student's 11th or 12th grade teacher.
5. Have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale.
6. Submit the Sunday School/Bible Study Attendance Verification Form which is completed by either your FABC Youth Bible Study or Sunday School teacher. The Sunday School/Bible Study Attendance Verification Form must indicate regular attendance.
7. Submit a headshot photo with your Scholarship Application.
8. Submit ALL required information by the **April 15, 2022** deadline.

If this is the case, then it must be noted on the form. Also, the form cannot be completed by a family member.
