Topic: When God Wants Us To Do Something
Chapters: Genesis 12 - 15 **August 24th, 2022**

Central Text: Joshua 24:2, NKJV, 2 And Joshua said to all the people, “Thus says the Lord God of Israel: ‘Your fathers, including Terah, the father of Abraham and the father of Nahor, dwelt on the other side of the River in old times; and **they served other gods.**”

Intro: Where they were / Where we are / The Process of Devolution: **Romans 1:18-32**

What’s required of us when God wants us to do something?

1.Come Out Of Idolatry - Genesis 11:27-12:20,

Question for Dialogue: (For Personal Reflection) What idol have you recently struggled to tear down in your heart?
(For participation) Why is it so hard to remove idols out of our life that vie for our attention, affection, and engagement?

2.Believe That What God Has For Us Is For Us By Faith - Genesis 13:14-18, NKJV,

Question For Dialogue: As long as we have an enemy, Satan, there will be threats to the work that God has begun in our life. How can we maintain **faith** in the midst of seasons when it seems like what God began in us won’t be finished?

3.Be Courageous, Because Courageous Acts Are Blessed & Covetous Acts Are Cursed - Genesis 14, NKJV,

Question For Dialogue: Helping others who have mistreated us takes courage. Yet, we must forgive otherwise God won’t forgive us, so what are some spiritual practices necessary to build up the courage to help others who have hurt us in the past?

4.God Cannot & Will Not Break His Promise, Because He’s Put Himself and His Son As A Guarantee - Genesis 15

Question For Dialogue: When doubt creeps in pertaining to a promise from our Father God our behavior begins to change. What are some effective ways to keep doubt at bay when we need to maintain faith in life’s storms and tests?
