Topic: The I AM's of Jesus
Subject: "I am the Light of the World."
Scripture Reference: Saint John 8:12

Introduction: As we understand that Jesus is the Light of the World, the Bible explains that the true source of light is Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ declared, "I am the light of the world" (Saint John 8:12). Whatever light we have comes solely from the light that Jesus Christ gives to us. Jesus is the source of light; Christians are the reflection of His light. Apart from Jesus we live in darkness. We have limited capacity to understand who we are or what we see in the world.

- +Jesus is the true light of the world. Saint John 1:4-5
- +Jesus becoming the light of the world points to His identity and purpose.
- +Since Jesus is the Light of the World, the believer will always tend toward spiritual things if he walks with him.
- +There are at least two promises that are given to followers of Jesus; one, he will never walk in darkness and two, he will be a reflection of Jesus.
- +In Saint John 8:12, I find that apart from Jesus we live in darkness.
- +Because Jesus is the Light of the World, the Christian may walk through dark places but he will be guided by the Lord of Lights.

Conclusion

John Piper declares that "Jesus speaks from God and for God and as God." Apart from Jesus, who is the Light, we live in darkness. We have a limited capacity to understand who we are or what we see in the world.
