

CONTINUING STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

FOR 2020-2022 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

All continuing student scholarship recipients who graduated from high school in 2020 - 2022 must meet the following requirements to continue receiving Franklin Avenue Baptist Church (FABC) Scholarship funds:

- Must maintain church affiliation with FABC or a church where you are under Watch Care* in the city where you are attending school. The required **Attendance Verification Form** must be completed and signed by your Bible Study or Sunday School teacher. If you are attending FABC then an **Attendance Verification Form** is required from your Bible Study or Sunday School teacher. If you are under Watch Care, the pastor of the Watch Care church must **mail** the **Attendance Verification Form** to FABC. **The Attendance Verification Form must indicate regular attendance to be considered for the scholarship.**
- Must request an **OFFICIAL FINAL SPRING OR SUMMER** college transcript be **mailed** from the college/university/technical/trade school directly to FABC New Orleans by deadline of **July 4, 2023**.
- Must meet the GPA requirements according to the following:
 - \$750 college GPA must be 2.00 or above
 - \$1,500 college GPA must be 2.40 or above
 - \$2,250 college GPA must be 3.00 or above

GPA requirement must be met at the end of the spring term. However, if the summer term immediately following the spring is used to increase your GPA, you must submit all required documentation along with an **Appeal Form** for scholarship reconsideration.

- Must be in good academic standing with the institution attending.
- Must be a full-time student each term, excluding audited courses. Summer enrollment is not required, nor will courses taken in the summer be included in the count of full-time status in a regular term.

Provided you meet the above requirements, your scholarship award will be the same as the original amount and you will continue to receive funds each year for four (4) years unless you graduate earlier. Please refer to the **Appeals Form** if you encounter any extenuating circumstances.

Watch Care is a term used when you place temporary membership at a host church for a period of time. During the period of "Watch Care", you will be an active member sitting under the preaching/teaching of the minister of the host church, until you return to your home church of Franklin Avenue Baptist Church. In the event that you may experience a challenge in selecting a Watch Care host church, you **must contact Pastor Fred "Chip" Luter, Jr. so that he may assist you in locating a host church/ministry within the community of your university/college.*
