Question Driving Study Of Chapter 6 - What's the proper response to an encounter with God? **Read verses 1-13**

Question for Dialogue - We all have been stubborn in the past, and even now can lean toward stubbornness in our approach to doing God's will, **so how can we approach a sinful world with God's message in an empathizing way?**

Question Driving Study Of Chapter 1 - How does a Holy God show love to sinners? **Read verses 1-31**

Question for Dialogue: Believers need to leave God's role to God, and *clearly understand what our role is in seeking to make disciples of Jesus*. **It's not our role to come after the sin of the person; that's God's job.** *Instead, we need to lovingly come after the person no matter their sin, which sets the proper atmosphere for the Holy Spirit to win them for Christ.* **What are some ways we can lovingly pursue people no matter their sin?**

Question Driving Study Of Chapter 5 - Is God justified in judging Judah? **Read verses 1 - 30**

Question for Dialogue: Discipline from God is never easy, yet He has to do it in order to correct our wayward behavior, so we'll get back to revering and respecting Him. **How did you respond the last time the Lord convicted you of sin? Also, how were you different afterwards and what did you learn about God?**

Question Driving Study Of Chapter 7 & 8 - When danger arises what do we do and who should we call on? Read Verses 1 - 25

Question for Dialogue - When we're under threat by man or under threat of a negative report, fear arises and can prevent us from standing firm and being established by faith and belief in God. Wallowing in fear and our own solutions will cause us to be chastised by God. **How can we fight fear and stick to God's direction on how to move forward?**

Question Driving Study Of Chapter 9 - 10:4 - Why at the same time punishment is decreed is the promise of reconnection and redemption given? **Read Chapter 9 - 10:4**

Question For Dialogue - Even in our foolish sins and unbelief Jesus loves us, because he calls Himself an "Everlasting Father chp.9:6." **How can we walk in and under this loving covering and affirmation when in the middle of frustration, attack from adversaries, and uncertainty?**

Question Driving Study Of Chapter 10:5 - 27 - Who is the one who makes all things right? **Read Verses 5 - 27**

Question For Dialogue - God has power to bring down our oppressors. Identify the person you need to turn over to God and trust that God will humble them as He cares for you. **How can we live with security in God when we're surrounded by antagonizers inside and/or outside of our circles of influence?**

Question Driving Study Of Chapter 11 - 12:6 - What will God's Millennial Kingdom be like? **Read Chapter 11-12:6**

Question For Dialogue: Everything we hate about this world will be renewed and restored in Heaven, so we can praise God now as He works His plan of salvation for His children. **What are you most looking forward to about Heaven?**
