1.Acts 19
Question for Dialogue: There's a difference between equipping the saints and evangelizing the sinners. We're more comfortable equipping the saints, because they already believe what we believe. How can we break out of our comfort zones to begin intentionally sharing Jesus' message of salvation?
2.Acts 20
Question for Dialogue: Living as a godly example is important for Christians because if our lifestyle is consistent with the message of salvation we share with people, God can use that combination to win souls into His Kingdom. The assignment that God has given us must be completed with endurance. How can believers overcome trials and threats of future danger to stand on God's word and finish our God-given assignment?
3.Acts 21
Question for Dialogue: Satan will falsely accuse us of things in an attempt to stop us from giving God glory by testifying and evangelizing. How should believers handle it when people falsely accuse us of things?
4.Acts 22
Question for Dialogue: Telling people the circumstances surrounding why we accepted Jesus is a practice that every believer should consistently practice. Every salvation story should include how we turned from our way to Jesus' way, and what God did for us the moment we accepted Him. <b>Do you have a short salvation testimony that you can share in a few words?</b>

Question for Dialogue: No matter how nice and kind we are as Christians, our enemy Satan doesn't care. He will use demonic forces within people, who've made themselves available as vessels to antagonize us. How can we fortify ourselves against the enemy's attacks that will come our way while we do God's will?
