Why Did Jesus Become a Man?

I. Jesus Became a Man to Satisfy the Prophecies of the Old Testament

- A child to be born. *Isaiah 9:6/Luke 2:11*
- A child to be born of a virgin. *Isaiah 7:14 / Matthew 1:21-23*

II. Jesus Became a Man to Show Us the Father

- Jesus is the way that you know God. *John 14:6*
- Jesus was God in a body. *John 14:8-9*

III. Jesus Became a Man to Save Us from Our Sins

- The reason Mary gave birth to Jesus. *Matthew 1:21*
- Jesus offers salvation to all who come to Him. *1st Timothy 1:15*

IV. Jesus Became a Man to Sympathize with Our Weakness

- Jesus was tempted like all of us. *Matthew 4:1*
- However, Jesus' temptation did not lead Him to sin. *Hebrews 4:15-16*

V. Jesus Became a Man to Secure Our Hope of Heaven

- Jesus came down so that we could go up. *Colossians 1:27*
- The only way you can live in Heaven is Christ living in you. *John 14:1-6*
