Topic: Compassion Matters
Book Theme: Faith, Obedience, & Deliverance
Chapters: Exodus 1 - 4 **Apr. 17th, 2024**

Central Text: Exodus 3:7, NKJV, 7 And the Lord said: “I have surely *seen the oppression* of My people who are in Egypt, and have *heard their cry* because of their taskmasters, for *I know their sorrows*. 8 So *I have come down to deliver them* out of the hand of the Egyptians, and *to bring them up* from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites.....

1. Stand For God’s Word When Society Tries To Get You To Do Otherwise - Exodus 1

Question For Dialogue: Have you ever been asked to do something that didn’t align with God’s word? How did you handle the situation?

2. Have Compassion: See, Feel, & Act - Exodus 2

- The Egyptian Woman’s Compassion, Moses’ Compassion, God’s Compassion

Question for Dialogue: When was the last time you saw a situation, felt compassion, and acted on your compassion? How did that situation turn out?

3. The Call Of The Vessel Of God’s Compassion - Exodus 3

Question for Dialogue: When have you felt God’s calling on your life to serve in a particular ministry, or carry out a particular service in your community or for your family?

4. Equipping The Vessel Of God's Compassion and The Early Response Of God's People Israel - Exodus 4

Question for Dialogue: God has a way of removing every excuse we make for not serving a purpose He's called us to fulfill. *Can you recall any excuses you gave that God removed, and then you followed His desire for you to act on a particular situation?*
