1.Remarkable Grace of God - Exodus 17:1-7
Question For Dialogue: We don't deserve Jesus' salvation, similar to how Israel didn't deserve God's provision of water at Rephidim. What have you learned about the grace of God at Rephidim that informs how you would like to interact with God?
2.Physical Battles Require Spiritual Tactics - Exodus 17:8-16
<u>Question for Dialogue:</u> We all have lost emotional battles that <u>caused us to sin</u> . Yet, there have been some emotional battles we've won by <u>relying on God</u> . What are some <u>character adjustments</u> that must be made to prevent our <u>emotions from leading us into sin</u> ?
3.Our Examples of Courageous Faith Inspires Others - Exodus 18:1-12
Question for Dialogue: Our days are numbered. We've been given life because God has an assignment for our lives. Once our assignments are over, God will call us home. What area of your life requires courageous faith?
4.Strategic Leadership - Exodus 18:13-27
Question for Dialogue: Just because we've always done something a certain way doesn't mean it's the best way to get a done. What are some ways we can improve our leadership?
