Introduction to the Book of Lamentations

Notes taken from the Holman Illustrated Handbook:

- Author and Date of Writing:
 - o Unknown, perhaps Jeremiah, written soon after 586 B.C.
 - According to 2 Chronicles 35:25
- Audience: Jewish witness to Jerusalem's fall.
- Key Text: Lamentations 1:1 "How she sits alone, the city once crowded with people! She who was great among the nations has become like a widow. The princess among the provinces has been put to forced labor."
- Key Term: "Lament" a "lament" or "lamentation" is a formal expression of grief in the face of loss or death. This book expresses the anguish the author felt over the fall of Jerusalem.
- One-Sentence Summary:
 - o A skillful and emotional poet described the devastation of the city of Jerusalem brought by the Babylonians but ultimately caused by the Lord's anger against his people - and poured out his own personal expressions of sorrow.
