Topic: Disorders of the Christian Tongue-Ephesians 4:30-32

Introduction: The enemy (Satan) is always seeking to control our minds. Our minds are the part of the image of God where God communicates with us and reveals His will to us.

DEFINITION OF THESE DISORDERS

Disobedience - refusing to comply with the teachings of the Word of God.

Bitterness - A resentful spirit that results in hostility toward others. It is that state of mind which willfully holds on to angry feelings, ready to take offense, able to break out in anger.

Wrath - the exhibition of an enraged sinful nature, hostile, intense anger, rage directed toward individuals.

Anger - Strong emotional reaction of displeasure, often leading to plans for revenge or punishments toward individuals.

Clamor – an outcry made with a loud human voice continued or repeated which expresses complaint and urgent demand toward those who we feel have hurt us.

Evil Speaking – anything mentioned about a person with the intent to perform injury to another, whether the statement is true or false.

Malice - an intent to commit an unlawful act or cause harm without legal justification or excuse. A desire to cause pain, injury, or distress to another.

Conclusion: The cure for these disorders is found in Romans 12:1-2; Ephesians 4:32 and Philippians 4:8.
