How Should We Totally Surrender Our Lives in Obedience to God?

1.Heed God's Warnings and Never Stop Praying for Those Far From God – 1 Samuel 12:14-15, 23

Question for Dialogue: When did you discover the things of this world could not satisfy you? What helps your sin-nature not to pursue those things?

2. Prepare to be Tested with Uncertain Outcomes, so Trust God's Timing, Authority, & Resources -1 Samuel 13

Question for Dialogue: What uncertain outcome caused you anxiety and led you to pray? <u>Have you left it at Jesus' feet</u>?

3.Seek God to Establish Order Within Our Lives, Otherwise Chaos Will Breakout – 1 Samuel 14 - Notice God's favor in the midst of this. Where would we be without God's grace?

Question for Dialogue: There's a contrast from Jonathan seeking God to Saul seeking himself that teaches a pivotal lesson on healthy Christian living. <u>What victories have you secured from seeking God, and defeats from not doing so</u>?

4.When God Requests Something, We Must Yield, Otherwise God Sees it as Rejection & Opposition – 1 Samuel 15

Question for Dialogue: What has God asked you to let go of that you struggle to give up? *How do you believe it makes God feel when you put that before Him?*
