Key Text: 2 Sam. 7:16,20-21, 16 And your house and your kingdom shall be *established forever* before you. *Your throne shall be established forever.* 20 Now what more can David say to You? For You, Lord God, know Your servant. 21 For Your word's sake, and **according to Your own heart**, You have done all these great things, to make Your servant know them.

Let's Learn From:

1. God's Eternal Throne –2 Sam. 7

Question for Dialogue: God's choice of us for salvation, and deployment in His will to share His message with others, demonstrates His sovereignty, because not one of us deserves it or could have earned it. **What shocks you and blesses you at the same time regarding God's sovereignty in your life?**

2. Wars – 2 Sam. 8

Question for Dialogue: In 2 Sam. 7:11, God tells David that he "would give him rest from all his enemies," so David sets out to execute this in Ch.8 with God giving him the victory (Ch.8:6&14). There are seasons when we have to aggressively work for our peace, which may involve tension, hard conversations, and stern decisions. **How do we accept and carry out the active role to be an instrument of our peace with God's preordained victory?**

3. Kindness –2 Sam. 9

Question for Dialogue: Our legacy of kindness transcends us and impacts those we love. **Has someone you loved ever received kindness because of your kindness toward someone else? If so, how?**

4. Bad Advisors – 2 Sam. 10

Question for Dialogue: Godly counsel is critical for faithful Christian living. **Have you ever been saved from not taking bad advice by receiving and applying better advice? If so, what was the better advice you applied?**
