What the Bible Says About Hell

Part Two

In our last Bible Study series, I did a series on Heaven, the final dwelling place for all Believers in Jesus Christ. Last week, I began a study on the other final dwelling place for all non-believers in Jesus Christ, a place called Hell.

I. Definition: Hell is the final dwelling place of satan, his angels, and anyone who dies without trusting Christ as their Savior.

II. How Can a God of Love Allow Mankind to Go to Hell?

1. God does not want anyone to go to hell (*2nd Peter 3:9*). God provided salvation for mankind through the death of Jesus on the cross (*Romans 5:6-8*).
2. God is a God of love (*John 3:16*), but God is also a holy God (*1st Peter 1:15-16*), therefore God must punish sin.
