1. Jesus Turned Away from Petty Stuff - John 4:1-3

Question for Dialogue: Jesus didn’t want to be drawn into petty jealousies and comparisons. Have you ever been drawn into something petty? How was it resolved?

2. Jesus was Intentional - John 4:4-5

Samaritans - King Sargon of Assyria exiled Jews from Samaria to his foreign territories, and settled other ethnic groups, including Assyrians, in Samaria when he overran Israel. Many Jews from Samaria, originally known as Israeli’s or Judeans, intermarried with these foreigners, so Jews from other regions despised them because they didn’t consider them “pure” Jews. Racism and self-hate (internalized racism) aren’t new.

The Samaritans formed after the area was resettled with foreigners, and they began their own faith practices, which we’ll cover in a subsequent week.

Question for Dialogue: When have you sensed God leading you to be intentional in ministering to someone? How did it go?

3. Jesus Knew How to Get People’s Attention – John 4:6-8

Question for Dialogue: What are some things that we can do to get people’s attention, and once we have it, what should we do?
