Episodic - means happening occasionally, or being divided into separate, distinct parts or installments. It most commonly describes television shows or narratives where each installment is a standalone story and specific types of human memory related to recalling particular life events.

1. Show People a Remarkable Side of Christians - John 4:9

Christians are still human and must wrestle with frustrations, aggravations, and inner turmoil. We have access to the **power to be victorious** over our flesh that the world doesn’t have.

Question for Dialogue: *Who in your family, community, or job needs to see a remarkable side of Christians? **What, according to God’s word, are some things that Christians should be marked by?***

2. Don’t Miss Life-Changing Moments - John 4:10

Question for Dialogue: There are pivotal moments in our lives. Some can be considered tests of whether we’ll advance to a greater level of faith or not, or whether someone will accept Jesus for the first time or not. **Why do some people flee from Jesus instead of staying engaged with Jesus when fiery trials are allowed in their lives?**

3. Satisfaction From Jesus Far Surpasses the World’s Temporary Pleasures – John 4:11-14

Question for Dialogue: Describe the satisfaction you’ve secured from Jesus and how it has fueled and changed your lifestyle from one of self-centeredness to one of complete surrender to serve his daily will to be a disciple-maker.
