I. The Natural Mind vs. The Renewed Mind

1. There is always warfare between the worldly and the spiritual. *1 Corinthians 2:14*

II. The Benefits of Having a Renewed Mind

1. A Renewed mind is not confused about right and wrong. *James 4:4*
2. A Renewed mind is not caught up in the things of this world. *Romans 12:2*
3. A Renewed mind meditates on spiritual things. *Philippians 4:8*
4. A Renewed mind maintains focus, despite opposition. *Nehemiah 4:1-6*

III. How to Develop a Renewed Mind

1. Determine in advance that you will obey God's Word. *Joshua 1:7-9*
2. Remember who created you. *Psalms 139:13-14*
3. Remember God is always with you. *Romans 8:31*
4. Strive everyday to know and become like Christ. *Philippians 2:5-8*
