Sample Agenda

This resource is designed for co-teaching teams, including special education, general education, and service providers, to collaboratively plan lessons in response to student profiles, data, and observations. The purpose of this resource is to support collaborating teams in establishing a clear process for intentional planning.

Co-Teaching Planning Meeting Goals

- Collaborate in designing lessons and activities that respond to student profiles, data, and observations.
- Harness the expertise of all educators to clearly define actions and responsibilities.

— Agenda (60 minutes) —	
Welcome and Introduction (5 minutes)	 Engage in a community builder such as a shared question to further deepen relationships Clarify the purpose of the meeting and the goals for co-planning
Review of Student Profiles and Needs (10 minutes)	 Share insights from recent assessments or observations Discuss specific student profiles, strengths, challenges, and any updates Make notes of any next steps in shared progress monitoring templates
Identification of Learning Objectives (10 minutes)	 Define the key learning objectives for the upcoming lesson(s) Align objectives with student strengths and current areas of growth based on recent assessment and observation data Consider alignment with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) and IEP goals
Co-Teaching Model Selection (10 minutes)	 Determine the most suitable co-teaching model for the upcoming lessons (e.g., parallel teaching, station teaching, team teaching) that fits the lesson objective and current support students need
Lesson Planning (15-20 minutes)	 Collaboratively develop detailed lesson plan(s), incorporating what was surfaced in steps 2-4 above. Allocate responsibilities for specific tasks within the lesson (e.g., resource development, content delivery, student support)
Reflection and Next Steps (10 minutes)	 Reflect on the co-planning process and the effectiveness of strategies chosen Identify any adjustments or improvements for future co-planning sessions Determine action items and next steps
Closing Remarks (5 minutes)	 Recap key decisions and action items Confirm the date and time for the next co-planning meeting

Note: This agenda is a flexible guide, and the duration of each item can be adjusted based on the specific needs of the team and the complexity of the lesson planning.
