

PHC Partners with State Health Department to provide COVID-19 Testing

Priority Health Care in partnership with the Louisiana Department of Health provided additional community COVID-19 mobile testing last month, June 15 through Friday, June 26, 2020 (weekdays only). Jefferson Parish made two community centers in Harvey, Louisiana available as testing sites. Free walk-up testing was available to anyone who wanted to determine his or her COVID-19 status. Testing at these sites was available to individuals, age 2 and older, even those who were not experiencing symptoms.

In addition, we continue to take safety measures to protect our staff and patients by wearing masks, providing hand sanitizer, practicing physical distancing and offering virtual visits to patients. We also post updated information on our website, social media, and in our Marrero and Gretna clinics. We are updating our actions as the coronavirus situation changes based on recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control, and the Louisiana Department of Health as well as the City of New Orleans.
