# VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

Prossy Nabuufu, who was a caregiver to her mother during her cervical cancer journey, found her way to CanCare all the way from Uganda.

Prossy is a 36-year-old single mother of seven children, including three she adopted. She lives in a rural district of Uganda called Nakaseke, where she is a health worker and is working on her nursing degree.

"I heard about CanCare when I was the caregiver to my mother [during her] treatment," Prossy says.

Prossy applied for emotional support and was matched with a volunteer who also cared for a parent. "I was about to give up, but I thank that volunteer who helped me to gain hope."

After supporting her mother through her experience with cancer, Prossy decided to join the CanCare family by becoming a volunteer.

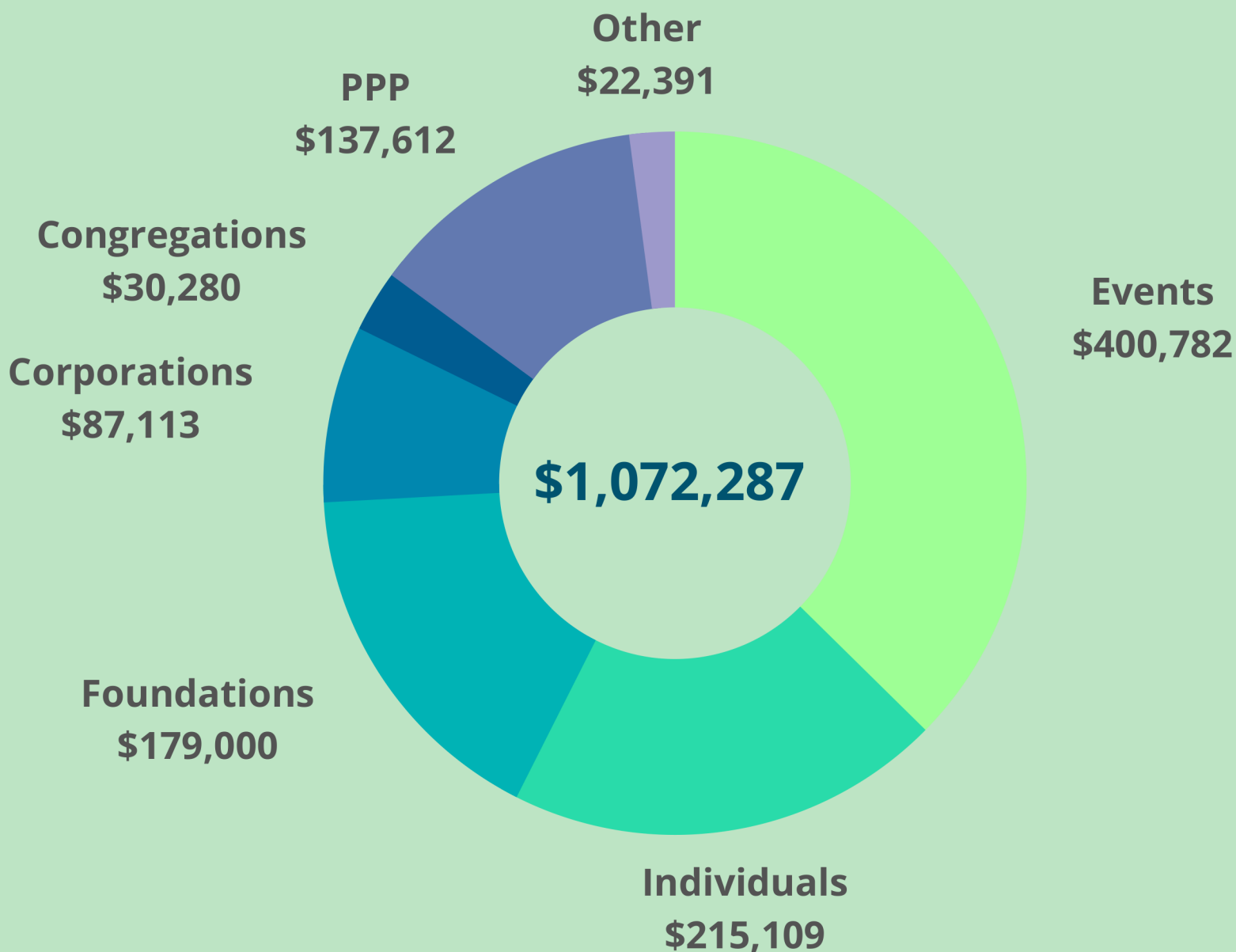

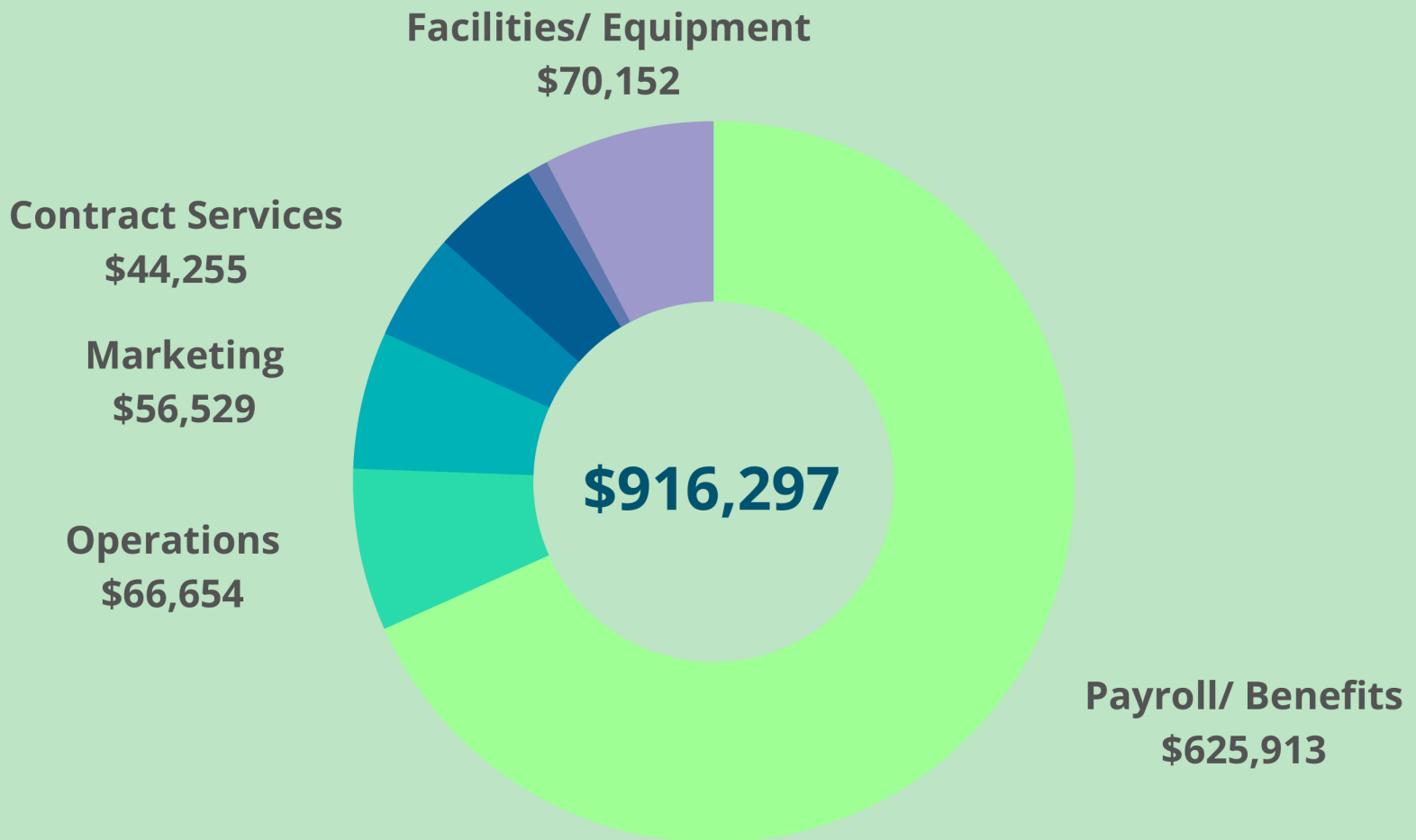
