## Proposed Clauses for Domestic Relations Order

I.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court finds the parties
in the above captioned matter were married to each other on1, 20, and were
subsequently divorced; that a community property regime existed during the marriage of
the aforesaid parties, which regime was terminated effective2, 20; and that
this court has jurisdiction of this action and these parties and is the proper Court to render
this order.
II.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court
finds that, during the existence of the aforesaid marriage,3, whose social
security number is, and whose mailing address is, was a
member of the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund ("CLERKS"), thereby
establishing a community property interest in funds or benefits that may become payable
by the CLERKS as a result of that membership.
III.
Alternative clause 1:
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that6,
whose social security number is, and whose mailing address is
8, shall receive9% of any funds or benefits that may become
payable by the CLERKS, including any cost of living adjustments, to
3, his/her survivor(s), or his/her beneficiary(ies).

## Alternative clause 2:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that6,
whose social security number is, and whose mailing address is
8, shall receive \$10 of any funds or
benefits that may become payable by CLERKS to3, his/her
survivor(s), or his/her beneficiary(ies) from the Deferred Retirement Option Plan
("DROP") only.
Alternative clause 3:
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that6
whose social security number is, and whose mailing address is
8, shall receive a percentage of any funds or benefits that may become
payable by CLERKS, including any cost of living adjustments, to3
his/her survivor(s) or his/her beneficiary(ies), said percentage to be calculated as follows
One half (1/2) of the fraction, the numerator of which is the number of years of service credit earned or purchased by3 during the existence of the aforesaid community property regime, to-wit, from1 until2, at the denominator of which is the total number of years of service credit3 has with CLERKS as of the date funds or benefits become payable by CLERKS, all in accordance with the formula set forth by the Louisiana Supreme Court in Sims v. Sims, 358 So.2d 919 (La.1978).
IV.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that CLERKS
divide any funds or benefits that may become payable by it to3, his/her
survivor(s) or his/her beneficiary(ies), with6 and that CLERKS pay th
aforesaid funds or benefits directly to6 at his/her above address, or such

other address as6 may advise CLERKS in writing in accordance with the
following paragraph.
V.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, should
3 die prior to his retirement and receipt of benefits, and leave no persons
entitled to survivors' benefits, then6 shall be entitled to
receive one-half (1/2) of all employee contributions made (including any payments for the
purchase of service credit) by3to CLERKS during the period
from1to
VI.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that6
shall provide CLERKS with a certified copy of this Order within thirty (30) days after it
is signed by the undersigned Judge, and that6 shall inform CLERKS in
writing of all future changes of mailing address within thirty (30) days after such change
of address becomes effective.
VII.
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that, if
6 predeceases3, all funds or benefits shall revert to
3, or his/her survivor(s).
