



EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Considering that the impact of the Tropical Storm Sally will be affecting Lafourche Parish beginning September 14, 2020 and following, and in order to protect our citizens and the impact on our public facilities, the 17th Judicial District Court and the Clerk of Court's office, and to protect the safety and property of the employees of this Court and the citizens of Lafourche Parish, and considering that it is hazardous and unsafe for the employees of the Office of the Clerk of Court to continue in the performance of their official duties, and considering that it is hazardous and unsafe for the citizens of this Parish to conduct business with the Clerk's Office,


I, Annette Fontana, duly elected Clerk of Court for the 17th Judicial District Court in and for the Parish of Lafourche, do hereby declare that all offices of the Clerk of Court for this District and Parish shall be closed on September 14, 2020 through September 15, 2020, for the reasons stated above, and with the authority stated in *La. R.S. 1, section 55E(2)*.
