Station Name: "PC-7"

Monument Location: The station is located in Pointe Coupee Parish, LA, 1.0 miles East of Melville, LA, 8.8 miles West-Southwest of Morganza, LA and 9.6 miles Northwest of Fardoche, LA. To reach the station from the intersection of LA HWY 10 and LA HWY 417, travel North on LA HWY 417 for approximately 270 feet and the station will be on the left.

Monument Description: The monument is a 9/16 inch stainless steel rod found in good condition and encased by a 6 inch PVC pipe with an aluminum access cover stamped "PC-7" from which the lid is missing. The station is 3.8 feet East of a barbed wire fence, 22.8 feet West of the centerline of LA HWY 417, 66.3 feet West of a power pole, and 1.1 feet East of an orange carsonite witness post.
