**Station Name: "PC-16"**

**Monument Location:** The station is located in Pointe Coupee Parish, LA, 2.5 miles East-Northeast of Lettsworth, LA, 6.6 miles West-Northwest of Tunica, LA and 4.6 miles North of Innis, LA. To reach the station from the intersection of LA HWY 1, and LA HWY 418 in Innis, LA, travel North on HWY 418 for 0.5 miles to the levee, turn left and continue along HWY 418 (Levee Rd.) for 4.4 miles to a levee ramp leading to the Angola Ferry, travel up the ramp to the top of the levee and right, the station is on the left side of the edge of the first cattle guard near the corner of the fence.

**Monument Description:** The monument is a 9/16 inch stainless steel rod set and encased by a 6 inch PVC pipe with an aluminum access cover stamped "PC-16". The station is 8.8 feet Southwest of the Southwest corner of a cattle guard, 13.7 feet West of the centerline of the levee, 3.0 feet South of the corner of a fence post, and 1.9 feet West of an orange carsonite witness post.
