The Spirit of MBS Award is a monetary award honoring the memory of MBS students who gained their angel wings while attending MBS or after 8th grade graduation, but prior to completing high school or college. These MBS angels left a lasting impression on the hearts of those they left behind, and their legacy lives among us each day. - demonstrate the fruits of the spirit: joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control
