

**ORLEANS CIVIL DISTRICT COURT FOR THE PARISH OF ORLEANS AND FIRST  
AND SECOND CITY COURT EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER IN RESPONSE TO  
HURRICANE IDA**

**ORDER**

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1, Pursuant to LA R.S. 1:55, and the inherent power of the Court, and considering the devastation caused by Hurricane Ida, including road closures, damage due to high winds, and flooding and the loss of power, for the safety of the public and court staff,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

The Civil District Court for the Parish of Orleans, First City Court, and Second City Court, and the Clerk of Civil District Court extend the previous closure order closing the court through Sunday, September 19, 2021. The Court will resume normal operations on Monday, September 20, 2021.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:**

Cases scheduled to be heard during the closure are hereby continued without a date, and will be rescheduled as soon as possible.
