We will be taking up a 2nd collection during mass for the refugees in Ukraine on March 26-27. Financial help is needed to provide humanitarian aid to the victims of war after further invasion of Russia onto Ukrainian soil and conflict escalation.

With millions of potential victims in Ukraine, funds will be used to provide vital medical supplies, care for the injured, along with food and shelter to those affected.

All funds submitted will be channeled through established networks via the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) to the Ukraine and surrounding countries, making the emergency response an international effort with trusted leaders who are already doing good work.
