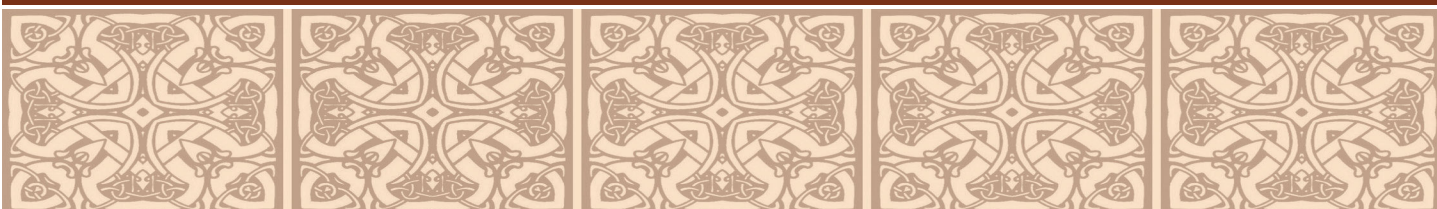

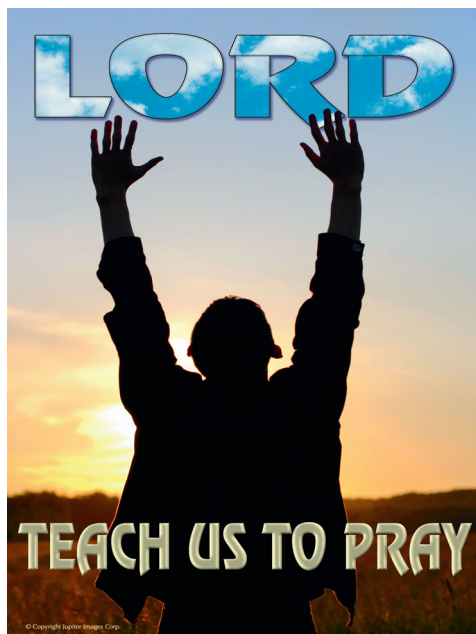

CONVERSATION WITH GOD

Prayer is our focus this weekend. In the Gospel, Jesus gives his disciples, and us, the Lord's Prayer, which we have cherished through the centuries. The first two words encompass much about our faith—unity among all Christians (Our), and a sense that we are in a deeply bonded relationship with God (Father).

In Genesis, we see Abraham in conversational prayer, in his creaturely humility before his Creator, seeking mercy and compassion for the innocent. The psalm is a lyrical prayer of thanksgiving and praise for the God who answered the sincere prayers of a people who had called out for help, showing them mercy. In Luke's Gospel, the disciples want to pray like Jesus, with the same intimacy—to experience God as Abba in the depths of their being.

Do we try to talk to God? Do we listen for answers? This relationship is always a work in progress.

Who needs to Register for PSR?

- ♦ Students in 1st through 10th grade who attend a public or non-Catholic private school.

- ♦ Students in 2nd grade who attend a public or non-Catholic private school, who homeschool, or who attend a Catholic school other than MBS.
- ♦ *MBS School 2nd graders will register for Sacramental Preparation in the Fall when school starts.*
- ♦ Students in 11th grade who will be preparing for Confirmation regardless of school attending. *Please note that each candidate must have completed 9th & 10th grade religious education either in Catholic school or PSR.*

**Mentorship Program for
Newly Released Inmates**

The world has dramatically changed in the past 30 to 40 years with the advent of cell phones, computers, websites and automobiles that plug into an electrical outlet. The impact can result in feelings of loneliness, isolation and even depression, leaving some formerly incarcerated to wonder if life on the modernized outside is even more difficult than behind prison walls.

A series of diocesan listening sessions to introduce a mentoring program for formerly incarcerated men and women will be conducted around the diocese in late July and early August. There will be three sessions in our area: August 11th at St. Jean Vianney in Baton Rouge, August 2nd at St. Gabriel Catholic Church in St. Gabriel and August 18th at St. John the Baptist in Brusly. Anyone who feels they may be called to serve as a mentor may want to attend. Interested parties need only attend one session. All sessions will run from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM. 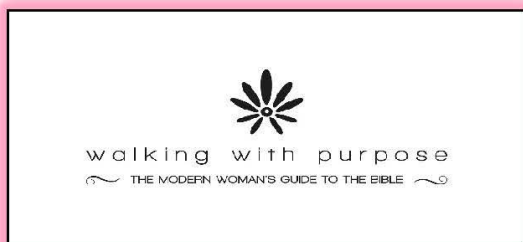
