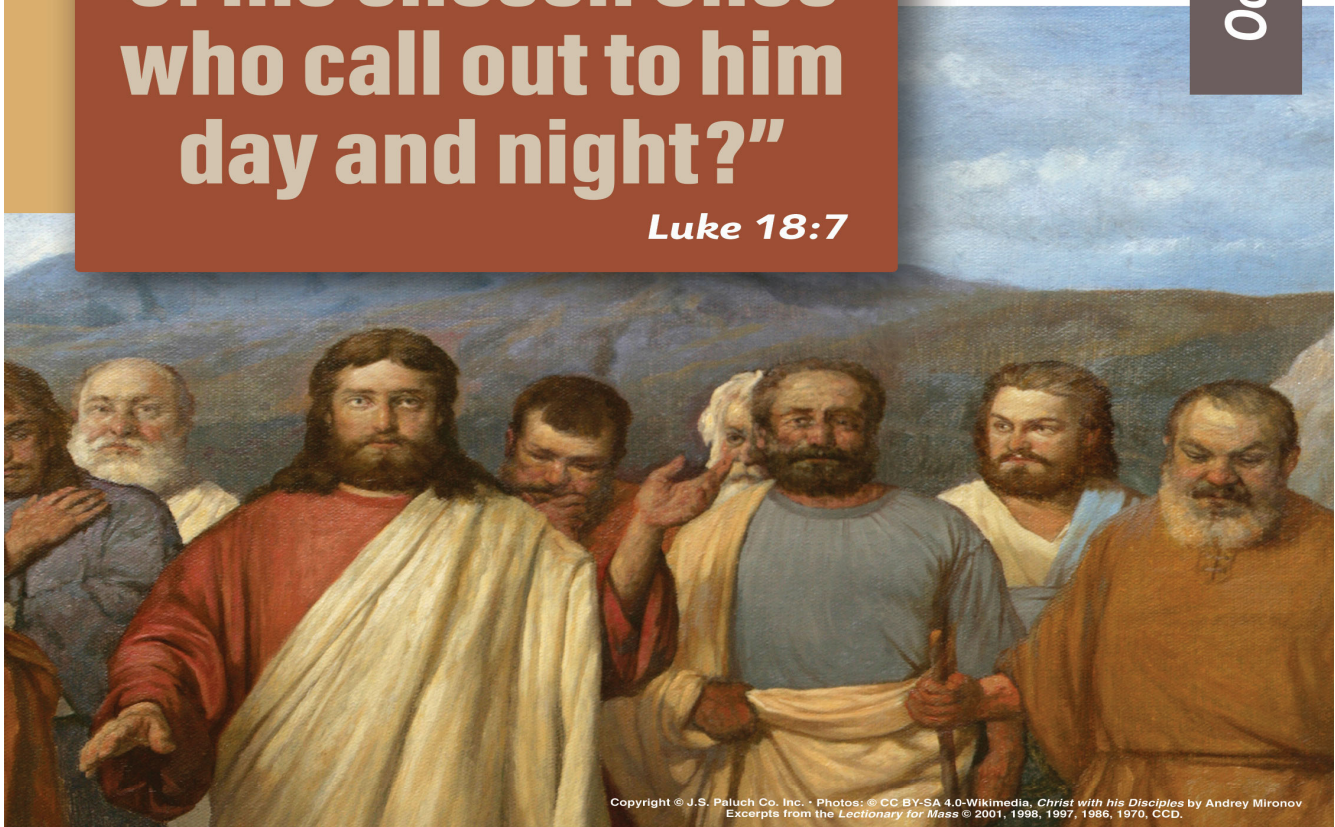

Fr. Dan Leary says "Thank You"

Visiting priest Fr. Dan Leary (on weekend of October 1-2) has asked Fr. Todd to express his heartfelt gratitude to each of the parishioners he was able to spend time with while preaching at recent weekend's Masses on the missionary work of the Sisters of Mary World Villages for Children. He was deeply moved by what he felt was an "uncommon generosity and goodwill" of Most Blessed Sacrament's parishioners.

In the next few weeks, we will make available the biography, *Priest and Beggar: the Heroic Life of Venerable Aloysius Schwartz*, which sold out after Masses that weekend. The book details the remarkable life of Fr. Al, who founded the Boystown and Girlstown mission for the 18,000 children that Fr. Dan leads now. Also, we will have Fr. 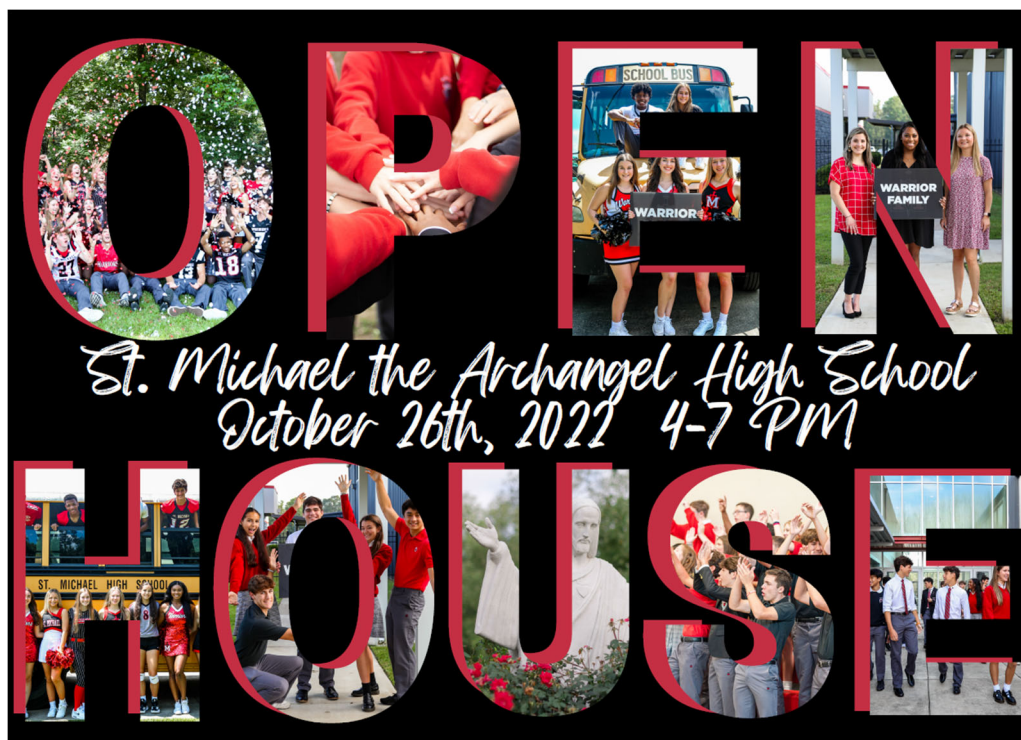


Holy Land Gifts - Olive Wood Carvings for sale after Masses on October 29th-30th



Holy Land Gifts, represented by the Rashmawi family who are volunteer members from the Roman Catholic Church in Bethlehem, will be visiting our Parish the weekend of November 13/14 and sell their olive wood gifts. They will speak to us about the dire Christian situation in the Holy Land. Their religious crafts are made in home workshops by Catholic families who make their day to day living by selling them to pilgrims and tourists that visit the holy sites and shrines. With the hostilities worsening in the Holy Land and a lack of Christian pilgrims, the traditional workshops of Olivewood have sustained severe damage. Therefore, unemployment there is at an all-time high, around 90%. The Christian community relies on services offered to pilgrims as a main source of income for the community. Olive wood items and carvings are the only tangible products they can produce and export. The Catholics of the Holy Land graciously ask your support through prayers and the purchase of these special religious art pieces. Proceeds of the sales generate much needed employment opportunities and monetary funds for 600 Catholic Families in Bethlehem. With the start of Advent season, consider these Gifts for your family, friends, and yourself and be as generous as God is to you.
