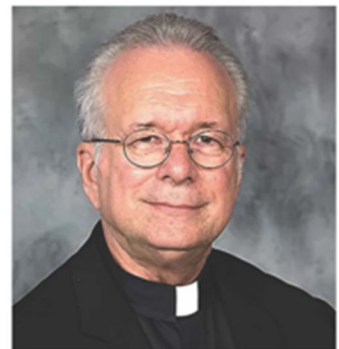
MASS BOOK NOW OPEN FOR 2023

About Our Speaker: Fr. Miles Walsh

Father Miles Walsh is a Louisiana native, who was ordained a priest in 1980. He served as director of Pastoral Formation of the Pontifical North American College in Rome, and while there he began doctoral studies in marriage and family life, which he completed at John Paul II Institute for the Study of Marriage and Family in Washington, D.C. in 2000. Afterwards, he temporarily served here at Most Blessed Sacrament Church until he became pastor of Our Lady of Mercy Catholic Church in 2001. Father Miles is recently retired from his position in the diocese of Baton Rouge as pastor of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. While in retirement, Father Miles is answering God's call to assist at the new retreat center, the Shrine of Our Lady of Hope in Chatawa, MS.

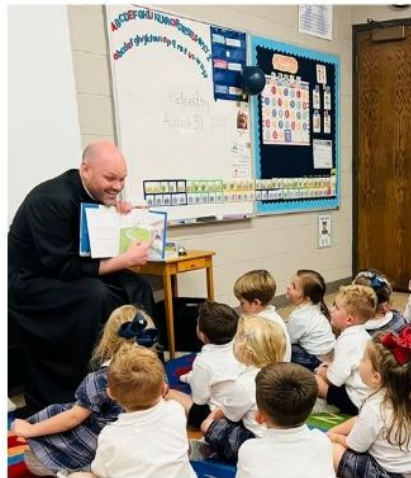
