

CASE STUDY: PHO VIET EXPRESS NOODLE HOUSE RESTAURANT BATON ROUGE, LA

Project Description:

Spencer's Contracting was selected as the general contractor to build out the interior suite for a new fast-casual restaurant at Heritage Crossing in Gonzales, LA. The suite is 1600 sq. ft. of retail storefront. We added a full kitchen, prep area, walk-in coolers, service bar, cabinetry, and dining area. We also added a drive-thru along the side of the restaurant for express pick-up. As you enter the restaurant you get a sense of the carefully planned décor and design that is as unique and appealing as the food they serve. It is our belief that this restaurant will be a popular eatery for the folks around Gonzales for the great food and the appealing environment.



CONDITION OF PROPERTY

- ▼ This was an empty "Gray Shell" retail suite
- The storefront glass and doors were all installed along with the entire exterior completed
- There were existing suites next door to this endcap that had already been built out when we started
- There was no electrical or HVAC, the plumbing had a common grease trap already installed, and the sewer line was stubbed up into the building

COST

- The cost range of construction for the interior build-out to a completed restaurant was approximately \$300,000
- ✓ Budgetary Cost of design & Engineering: Did not disclose
- Tenant Improvement dollars towards the cost of construction:
 Did not disclose
 - *Customer-supplied equipment was not included in the cost range of construction. This included kitchen equipment, dishwasher, hood equipment, walk-in cooler equipment, compartment sink equipment, and decorative lighting fixtures in the dining area.

TIMEFRAME

- Timeframe of Design & Engineering and permitting released: 8 - 10 weeks
- ✓ Timeframe of Construction: 2nd Quarter 2022
- ✓ Duration of Construction: 100 120 days (This did not include the design phase or permitting review time). The timeline was impacted by supply chain issues on equipment.

Work Performed

- Interior wall framing and sheetrock
- Electrical Panel and lighting fixtures throughout.
- All New Plumbing fixtures.
- New HVAC systems and ductwork
- Sheetrock finished ceiling and all walls finished sheetrock (Level 5) and painting throughout
- Installed new flooring.
- Installed new cabinetry and countertops in the Service Area
- Sneeze Guard tempered glass with minimum metal framing.
- High Counter Bar Seating.
- Custom back wall shelving with Bamboo wood planks
- Kitchen Hoods
- 🔀 Gas piping and installation
- Drive-thru window installation and brickwork around the opening.
- Walk-in cooler and freezer
- Installation of all customer-supplied equipment
